AN ACT TO AMEND \$80109(s)(9) OF CHAPTER 80, DIVISION 4 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY ON A LOAN PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED FOR THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §80109(s)(9) of Chapter 80, Division 4 of Title 10, Guam Code
- 3 Annotated, as amended by Public Law 30-235 and Public Law 32-43, is hereby
- 4 amended to read as follows:

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- 5 "(9) Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 6 of Title 5 of the
- 6 Guam Code Annotated, the government of Guam hereby waives immunity

from any suit or action in contract upon the loan and guaranty but *does not* waive sovereign immunity as to the personal liability of elected or appointed officials and employees of the government Guam. For the purposes of this provision only, immunity is also waived as to the award of attorney fees and related costs of the lender in connection with any suit brought by the lender to enforce any right or obligation incurred under the loan authorized hereby or in connection with the enforcement of any agreement, note or pledge that arises directly from the indebtedness authorized hereby."

**Section 2. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
