AN ACT TO AMEND § 80128 OF CHAPTER 80, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE GUAM PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM TO LEASE A PORTION OF ITS BUILDING FOR AN "INTERNET CAFÉ" FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING AND MANAGING A HIGH QUALITY AND REASONABLY PRICED CAFÉ.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 80128 of Chapter 80, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is
- 3 *amended* to read as follows:

"§ 80128. Authorization for Solicitation and Contracting for Lease.

- (a) The Guam Public Library System is hereby authorized to solicit and contract for the lease and operation of the Internet Café located at Nieves M. Flores Memorial Library in *Hagåtña* to provide drink and food services for library patrons and the general public, for the purpose of generating a source of revenue to support library infrastructure and attracting patrons to the establishment.
- (b) All funds received from the contract for the lease of the Internet Café *shall* be maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the government of Guam, and independent records and an independent bank account *shall* be kept in connection with this Fund. The revenue from the contract for the lease of the Internet Café *shall* be used for facility maintenance, improvements, supplies, and programs. The use of these funds *shall* be subject to the determination and approval of a majority of the Library Board members, and subject to legislative appropriation through the annual budget act.
- (c) Funds directed, as a result of revenue received from the contract for the lease of the Internet Café, *shall* be subject to an annual audit by the Office of Public Accountability.
- (d) The Library Board *shall* establish interim policy and procedures for the administration of this § 80128 until the promulgation of rules pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law."
