Torres for his outstanding leadership during his recent term as the Chief Justice of the Judiciary of Guam; and to extending Un Dångkulo' Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse to him for his excellent contributions and accomplishments in realizing significant progress in the administration of justice to the people of Guam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the Honorable Robert J. Torres served as the Chief Justice of the Judiciary of Guam, and as Chairman of the Judicial Council of Guam, from January 15, 2008 through January 18, 2011; and

WHEREAS, during Chief Justice Torres' three (3) years serving as the Chief Justice of the Judicial Branch of the government of Guam, significant progress and improvements were realized in numerous areas including, but not limited to: the establishment of the Northern Satellite Court; the creation of the Magistrate Judge position; the construction of the regional crime laboratory; the creation of the self-represented Litigants Kiosks; the creation of the DWI and Mental Health Therapeutic Courts; he spearheaded Guam's hosting of the 2010 Pacific Region Judicial Conference; he encouraged the development of a successful recycling and waste management program within the Judicial Branch; he created an active community partnership with the Department of Education through the Play By the Rules, Children at Risk, and the Anti-Bullying Programs; he developed a Judiciary Facilities Master Plan in anticipation of the impending military buildup, and the future requirements of the Judicial Branch; he successfully secured financial resources for the eventual enhancement of the Criminal Justice Information System; and he served as the Second Vice-President to the Conference of Chief Justices, exposing Guam's presence in the national arena; and

WHEREAS, Chief Justice Torres further expanded the Judiciary of Guam's overall involvement in community activities and programs, resulting in increased visibility of the court's presence throughout the island, including, but not limited to: improving the Law Week and Law Day activities, which earned the unique recognition by the American Bar Association for the Outstanding Law Day Activity Award for two (2) consecutive years; he encouraged the active participation of court employees and family members in the construction of a Liberation Day float within the government category, and which attained first place awards for three (3) consecutive years; and he increased Team Kotte's participation in community sporting activities, i.e., volleyball, basketball and softball; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, extend special recognition to the Honorable Robert J. Torres, Chief Justice Emeritus, for his exemplary service to the Judiciary of Guam in providing valuable leadership in the administration of justice and the enhancement of judicial services to all the people of Guam during his tenure as Chief Justice of the Judiciary, and for increasing the support and involvement of the Judiciary employees and management in community activities; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo' Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to him for his wonderful service and excellent contributions to the island community; and be it further
