WHEREAS, the Guam Community College (GCC) was established by Public Law 14-77 in 1977, to provide career technical education for Guam's public high school students, as well as providing post secondary programs, adult and continuing education, community education, and short-term, specialized training, which may be

- brought on and off campus, in satellite programs and on-site at businesses as needed;

- 3 WHEREAS, the College also serves as the State Board of Control for
- 4 Vocational Education under the United States Vocational Education Act of 1946, 1963,
- 5 and subsequent amendments; and
- 6 WHEREAS, GCC's mission is to be a leader in career and technical workforce
- 7 development by providing the highest quality education and job training in
- 8 Micronesia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, additionally, the College offers over fifty (50) courses of study
- which are job related and prepares students for transfer to four (4)-year colleges and
- 11 universities with advanced standing in professional and technical degree programs;
- 12 and
- WHEREAS, the College offers a variety of community service and special
- 14 programs to prepare students for college experiences, including English-as-a-Second
- 15 Language; Adult Basic Education; General Education Development (GED)
- preparation and testing; an Adult High School Diploma program; and an External
- 17 Diploma Program and Apprenticeship; and
- 18 WHEREAS, in the past two (2) years, with the advent of the anticipated
- military buildup on Guam, the College has seen a twenty-six percent (26%) increase
- 20 in its postsecondary enrollment, which signals an effort by many people to garner the
- 21 education and training they will need to be competitive in Guam's growing workforce;

- WHEREAS, the College's ten (10) Career and Technical Education programs
- 24 that are taught in all five (5) Guam public high schools have consistently served over
- 25 two thousand (2000) students since 2008; and

1 WHEREAS, the College has apprenticeship agreements with over seventy (70) 2 companies on the island, and is currently providing training to the employees of those 3 companies in order to increase their productivity and their earning power; and 4 WHEREAS, many of the effective members of this community have been part of the Guam Community College and they have contributed to society through the 5 practice of their different trades; and 6 7 WHEREAS, February has been designated as Career and Technical Education 8 Month through the efforts of the Association for Career and Technical Education, the 9 largest national education association dedicated to the advancement of education that 10 prepares youth and adults for successful careers; and 11 WHEREAS, the College will be holding its Open Campus Day on February 18, 2011 with activities that aim to provide participants with a vision of Guam's 12 13 sustainable workforce; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 14 15 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 16 of Guam, recognize and commend the Guam Community College for its contributions to the island community in developing an educated, productive and competitive 17 18 workforce through career and technical education; and does further congratulate them on the celebration of Career and Technical Education Month during Open Campus 19 Day on February 18, 2011; and be it further 20
