Relative to recognizing and commending Japan-based All Nippon Airways (ANA) on the celebration of its Twenty-fifth (25th) Anniversary of providing international air service, and to extending *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to them for contributing significantly to the economic development and the tourism industry in Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN**
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3 **WHEREAS,** All Nippon Airways (ANA) has planned three (3) charter flights
4 via jumbo aircraft Boeing 747s to Guam, in March 2011, in celebration of its Twenty-
5 fifth (25th) Anniversary of providing international air service; and

6 **WHEREAS,** these “sentimental flights”, as industry partners call them, are
7 scheduled to depart from Japan on the 3rd, 10th, and 18th of March 2011, and are
8 significant because they represent the growth of the tourism industry in Guam over the
9 last twenty-five (25) years; and

10 **WHEREAS,** these flights are also symbolic of the historical evolution of the
11 company, from the humble beginnings of a helicopter service, to a charter passenger
12 service, to a scheduled passenger service, to a start-up of cargo services on the trunk
13 line Tokyo-Osaka route, to a scheduled international service with the opening of a
14 Tokyo-Guam route twenty-five (25) years ago; and

15 **WHEREAS,** since that first All Nippon Airways flight departed from Tokyo
16 on March 3, 1986, visitor arrivals from Japan to Guam via All Nippon Airways,
17 along with their counterparts, Continental Airlines and Japan Airlines, have grown
18 exponentially; and

19 **WHEREAS,** ANA has reaped great success over the years, carrying a
20 cumulative total of 1 billion passengers on both domestic and international routes by
21 the year 2003, and continues to exceed this number with each scheduled flight; and

22 **WHEREAS,** this success was built on a foundation of security and reliability
23 that All Nippon Airways creates attractive surroundings for customers, continues to
24 be a familiar presence, and offers dreams and experiences to people around the
25 world; and

1 **WHEREAS**, All Nippon Airways has committed to the idea and practice that
2 safety is its promise to the public and the foundation of its business; that safety is
3 assured by an integrated management system and mutual respect; and that safety is
4 enhanced through individual performance and education; and

5 **WHEREAS**, All Nippon Airways strives to be a company that continues to
6 work for environmental sustainability through proactive efforts for the sake of people
7 and the Earth; and

8 **WHEREAS**, ANA continues to tackle challenges in order to sensitively
9 respond to environmental changes and social needs, and fulfill its social
10 responsibilities; and

11 **WHEREAS**, ANA's environmental principles are guided by the recognition
12 of the burdensome impact of activities to the Earth, the need to minimize the use of
13 natural resources and energy, and the need to engage and support the realization of a
14 more affluent society; and

15 **WHEREAS**, to this end, All Nippon Airways is keeping abreast with
16 internal and external developments relevant to global environmental issues in
17 consistently implementing measures to combat global warming, including the ANA
18 Group Ecology Plan; and

19 **WHEREAS**; All Nippon Airways undoubtedly exemplifies the meaning of a
20 great corporate system because it is a corporate company that focuses on financial
21 aspects, but also strikes a good balance with society and the environment; now,
22 therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
24 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend All Nippon Airways for its
25 committed service to Guam, and on the celebration of its Twenty-fifth (25th)
26 Anniversary of providing international air service; and does further extend *Un*

1 *Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to ANA for contributing significantly to the economic
2 development and the tourism industry in Guam; and be it further

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
4 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to All
5 Nippon Airways; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
