WHEREAS, Dr. Reinman worked in partnership with many *Chamorro* people on this extensive study, as well as the Micronesian Area Research Center, to process artifacts and materials recovered in the excavations, empowering local people and institutions in these important processes; and

WHEREAS, in 1974, the historically important site of *Pågat* was excavated initially by Dr. Reinman; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Reinman has written numerous books and articles on the archeological resources of our island, and thus made this important information available to our people, and to those who are interested in our history; now, therefore, be it
