Relative to recognizing and honoring Dr. Fred Reinman for his work in the archeological, historical and cultural preservation of the legacy of the people of Guam, and for his excellent service and dedication to the people of Guam and Micronesia; and to further extending a sincere *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for the outstanding contributions he has made for the betterment of our island community.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***

3 **WHEREAS, Dr. Fred Reinman has been committed to the archeological**
4 **identification and preservation of the historical resources of the island of Guam and its**
5 **people for more than fifty (50) years; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Reinman endeavored to complete the first survey of the
2 ancient sites throughout Guam, and the identifying and cataloguing of one hundred
3 thirty-eight (138) *Latte* sites on our entire island, totaling approximately two hundred
4 fifty (250) individual *Latte* homes and the archeological artifacts that surrounded
5 those villages, including the burial grounds of our ancestors; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Reinman worked in partnership with many *Chamorro* people
7 on this extensive study, as well as the Micronesian Area Research Center, to process
8 artifacts and materials recovered in the excavations, empowering local people and
9 institutions in these important processes; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1974, the historically important site of *Pågat* was excavated
11 initially by Dr. Reinman; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Reinman has written numerous books and articles on the
13 archeological resources of our island, and thus made this important information
14 available to our people, and to those who are interested in our history; now, therefore,
15 be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
18 of Guam, recognize and commend Dr. Fred Reinman for his work in the
19 archeological, historical and cultural preservation of the legacy of the people of Guam,
20 and for his excellent service and dedication to the people of Guam and Micronesia;
21 and does further extend a sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for his
22 important undertakings, and for the outstanding contributions he has made for the
23 betterment of our island community; and be it further

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
25 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
