3 WHEREAS, eight (8) years ago, when the Direct Instruction Program was

started on Guam, only ten percent (10%) of all fifth graders were able to read fourth-4

grade material. Today, as a testament to the Direct Instruction Program, fewer than

ten percent (10%) of J. Q. San Miguel's fifth-grade students are reading below a 6

fourth-grade level; and

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WHEREAS, on March 11, 2011, twenty (20) high-performing students of Mr.
Andrew Talbot's fifth grade class at J. Q. San Miguel Elementary School became the

first class on Guam to ever complete the top level of the Reasoning and Writing

4 language program of Direct Instruction before the end of the fifth grade; and

WHEREAS, in completing Level F of Reasoning and Writing, the twenty (20) fifth graders learned the skills of a sixth grade level class. The students gained knowledge of inductive, deductive and analogical reasoning skills. They also learned how to write reports; how to make arguments with supportive evidence; how to critique arguments; and how to determine the strength of supportive and non-supportive evidence in arguments; and

WHEREAS, the same fifth grade students are two (2) years ahead in reading, having completed the top level of Reading Mastery last year as fourth graders, and are on grade level in math, with the exception of one (1) student. These students will now set out to reach a new goal and begin a middle-school level course, studying different topics, and the different styles of writing, including narrative, persuasive, expository and descriptive styles of writing; and

WHEREAS, the success of these students would not have been made possible without the unwavering support of their teachers and parents. Their sustaining encouragement has allowed these students to perform to the best of their ability, and to reach these remarkable achievements in the program of Direct Instruction; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, congratulate Mr. Andrew Talbot's 5th grade class of J. Q. San Miguel Elementary School on their accomplishments, and on being the first group on Guam to complete the top Level of the Reasoning and Writing language program of Direct
