1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***

3        **WHEREAS, George Lai, as the founder of Quality Distributors, has led the**  
4        **company into its twenty-third (23<sup>rd</sup>) year of operation on the island of Guam; and**

1       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Lai has helped Quality Distributors to become one of the  
2 leading and largest food wholesalers and distributors on Guam and Saipan; and

3       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Lai continues to preserve the company's excellent track  
4 record in providing the best quality products, prices and services to the island  
5 community; and

6       **WHEREAS**, in March 2011, Quality Distributors, under the leadership of  
7 George Lai, was awarded a federal contract by the Defense Supply Center-  
8 Philadelphia (DSCP), as Prime Vendor of Guam, to provide food distribution services

6 hands of Guam's children; and


7 **WHEREAS**, George Lai maintains an active role in participating in Guam's
