**Relative to extending a special tribute and honor to Guam's men and women in uniform who have rendered the ultimate sacrifice in giving their lives while serving as peace officers and protecting the people of Guam in the line of duty; and to further extending appreciation to the family members who provided their personal love and support to these peace officers, as we commemorate "Peace Officers' Memorial Day" on May 16, 2011.**

1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS**, on October 1, 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed into law  
4        legislation that designated May 15 annually as a special day to honor peace officers in  
5        communities nationwide, for their commitment and service in the protection of  
6        citizens from criminal activities, especially extreme violence and terrorism; and

7        **WHEREAS**, on this special day set aside to honor peace officers, Guam joins  
8        communities throughout the nation in paying honor and recognition to the courageous  
9        men and women who dedicate their lives to enforcing the laws, protecting citizens  
10       from injustice, and providing public safety services for all of Guam's people; and

11       **WHEREAS**, every single day, peace officers throughout the island are asked to  
12       place themselves in harm's way to protect the community and to provide for the  
13       public's safety, and at times this may require that they risk their lives and pay the  
14       ultimate price, which is at a tremendous cost to the community, but also a valuable  
15       service in the protection of our island and its people; and

16       **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam will observe "Peace Officers' Memorial Day"  
17       on May 16, 2011, which is a time to acknowledge the men and women in uniform  
18       who have paid the ultimate sacrifice while serving in the line of duty, and have given  
19       of their lives in the protection of life and property for the people of Guam; and

20       **WHEREAS**, the following individuals have served as peace officers for the  
21       people of Guam, and have given of their lives: Police Sergeant, †Frankie E. Smith;  
22       Police Officer I, †Francisco D. Taitague; Police Officer I, †Juan M. Santos; Police  
23       Officer I, †Francisco A. Reyes; Police Officer III, †Thomas M. Sablan; Civilian  
24       Volunteer Police Reserve Officer, †Rudy C. Iglesias; Civilian Volunteer Police  
25       Reserve Officer, †Helen K. Lizama; Police Officer I, †Raymond S. Sanchez; Police  
26       Officer I, †Manuel A. Aquino; Police Lieutenant, †Francisco C. Toves; Police Officer

1 I, †Eddie A. Santos; Conservation Officer, †Francisco M. Isezaki; Drug Enforcement  
2 Administration Special Agent, †Larry D. Wallace; Department of Corrections Officer,  
3 †Douglas W. Mashburn; United States Air Force Airman, †Laurie Lucas; and United  
4 States Air Force Sergeant, †Stacey E. Levay; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the family members of the fallen peace officers, which includes  
6 their spouses, children and parents, should be recognized and appreciated for the  
7 tremendous support they had provided to their loved ones while they were dedicating  
8 their lives for the public's safety, in their honorable service to the law enforcement  
9 community, and the island of Guam and its people; now, therefore, be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*  
11 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
12 of Guam, extend a special tribute and *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the  
13 honorable men and women who proudly served the people of Guam, and gave the  
14 ultimate sacrifice of their lives in the line of duty; does extend acknowledgement and  
15 appreciation to the family members, including the spouses, children and parents, of  
16 the fallen peace officers who had given their lives in service to the island community;  
17 and does further encourage the people of Guam to join in the commemoration of  
18 "Peace Officers' Memorial Day" on May 16, 2011; and be it further


19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules

24 Administration, Guam; to the United States Air Force, Guam; and to the Honorable  
25 Edward J. B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.


