WHEREAS, our hospital provides all customary acute care services and certain specialty services that include adult and pediatric medical services; inpatient and outpatient surgery; intensive care (neonatal, pediatric and adult); skilled nursing care; laboratory and comprehensive blood bank services; radiology, nuclear medicine and CT scan diagnostic services; pharmacy; respiratory care; renal dialysis; physical, occupational, speech, language pathology and recreational therapy; dietetic services; and twenty-four (24)-hour emergency services; and

Pathologists (CAP); its mammography program is certified by the American College
of Radiology and the Food and Drug Administration; and its nuclear medicine
program is accredited by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission; and
