**Relative to recognizing, commending and extending *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to Ms. Mary Pangelinan Eclavea for her dedication to the education of our children and families for nearly four (4) decades.**

1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3        **WHEREAS,** Mary Pangelinan Eclavea was born on September 12, 1951, her  
4        parents are Priscilla Pangelinan Eclavea and Jose Miner Eclavea, and she was raised  
5        in the village of *Sinajana*;

1       **WHEREAS**, Mary attended *Sinajana* Elementary School, Saint Jude Thaddeus  
2 Junior High School (now Bishop Baumgartner Memorial School), and the Academy  
3 of Our Lady of Guam, where she graduated in 1969; and she then went off-island in  
4 pursuit of higher education, and attended the Mount Saint Mary College in California;

5       **WHEREAS**, Mary earned a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology and returned to  
6 Guam, where she became certified in Education, and in 1973, she stepped into her  
7 first role as an Educator when she started teaching at several Guam Department of  
8 Education (DOE) public schools, including *Adelup* Elementary School, Wettengel  
9 Elementary School, Maria Ulloa Elementary School, Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary  
10 School; and finally, at Baltazar P. Carbullido Elementary School, where she had  
11 continually made invaluable contributions, before she decided to step out of the  
12 classroom in 2003 to serve as a Direct Instruction Coordinator;

13       **WHEREAS**, throughout her career, Mary has been tireless and inspirational,  
14 casting the mold for educational achievement at Carbullido Elementary, where she  
15 was one of the pioneers of the Department of Education Extended Day, or DEED,  
16 pilot program at the *Barrigada* model school; implementing the multi-age program;  
17 serving as chairwoman for nearly every content area; serving as part of the school  
18 team responsible for developing the "homework planner," which continues to be used  
19 today, and which was lauded by the U.S. DOE as being "102 percent" effective, as it  
20 promoted communication and collaboration between teachers and families leading to  
21 student success; she participated in the development of the DOE student performance  
22 standards and indicators; she served as the Summer School Coordinator, she served as  
23 a Master Teacher for UOG Student Teachers; and she was instrumental in setting the  
24 foundation of the Direct Instruction program when Carbullido Elementary was one (1)  
25 of five (5) pilot schools;

1       **WHEREAS**, Mary is a proud mother, and mother-in-law, of Michael and Lisa  
2 Lujan Eclavea; Morris and Eva Eclavea Aguon; Jerrad and Josette Eclavea Cruz;  
3 Mariam Eclavea and Jose Eclavea; and she is also the proud grandmother of Rebecca,  
4 Sabrina, Olivia, Nathan, Joseph, Isaiah, Seth and Elan; now therefore, be it

6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
7 of Guam, recognize, commend and thank Ms. Mary Pangelinan Eclavea for her
