3        **WHEREAS**, during times of a weak economy when many of our people face  
4        financial hardships, and jobs are sparse and gas prices continue to escalate at a record  
5        pace, one local family has stepped up to the entrepreneurial plate and has joined in  
6        Guam's economic backbone, which is our small business sector, not only seizing on a

1 business opportunity for themselves, but also creating opportunities and jobs for  
2 others; and

3       **WHEREAS**, John A. Ananich, along with his brother, Jose, have developed  
4 Protective Armor Coatings of the Pacific, Inc., doing business as Armor Coatings  
5 Micronesia, looking to become Guam's premiere residential and commercial  
6 protective coating solutions company. In its short existence, and even before its Grand  
7 Opening, Armor Coatings Micronesia has already employed fourteen (14) local  
8 residents, and they have empowered two (2) companies with training and product  
9 knowledge to become independent dealers, in addition to donating the flooring at all  
10 of the chemistry labs located within the new John F. Kennedy High School; and

11       **WHEREAS**, Armor Coatings Micronesia, exclusive distributors of Vortex,  
12 Granitex, Eco-Meric, Oxygenics, Power Cost Monitors, and Counteract, are in the  
13 business of strengthening and protecting our homes, and commercial and public  
14 buildings, including our schools, areas that we, including our children, frequent; and

15       **WHEREAS**, this business endeavor is the perfect progression for two (2) men  
16 who have spent their lives protecting and serving our community in various capacities  
17 of law enforcement: Jose, who started his law enforcement career as a Corrections  
18 Officer, has been patrolling Guam's streets now for the past decade as a Police Officer  
19 I in the Guam Police Department (GPD). John, in order take on the Company  
20 President and Managing Director's role, has become a Police Reservist with GPD.  
21 John is also a member of the Guam National Guard and has served a tour in  
22 Afghanistan; and

23       **WHEREAS**, the impending transfer of over seven thousand (7,000) U.S.  
24 Marines, their families and support personnel from Okinawa create both uncertainty  
25 and opportunity, Armor Coatings Micronesia, a company whose owners are from  
26 Guam, for Guam and of Guam, will be one of the local companies working to be a

1 part of the Guam buildup that will last way beyond the military expansion, and help  
2 create the balance between economic prosperity and cultural preservation on our  
3 island; and

4 **WHEREAS**, with the help and support of government leaders and business  
5 organizations, such as the Guam Chamber of Commerce and the Guam Contractors  
6 Association, small, local businesses such as Armor Coatings Micronesia will prosper  
7 and grow into larger entities, meeting and beating its owners' expectations, and  
8 eventually employing hundreds of residents, imparting knowledge on to our people,  
9 and creating opportunities for future local entrepreneurs; and

10 **WHEREAS**, if the success of Armor Coatings Micronesia is hinged on the hard  
11 work, determination and perseverance of the Ananich men, and mirrors the strength  
12 and stability of each of their families, then the company will be prosperous and  
13 solvent, and they will be in business for a long time; now therefore, be it

15 on behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate Mr. John A. Ananich, President and  
16 Managing Director, his brother, Mr. Jose P. Ananich, and the investors, management  
17 and staff of Armor Coatings Micronesia on the occasion of their Grand Opening; and  
18 does further extend *Un Dangkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* to them for a combined forty  
19 (40) years of service in law enforcement on Guam; and be it further
