1 **WHEREAS**, in 1999, Joyce started Cars Plus with her husband, Joey
2 Crisostomo, as a used car lot and as the authorized service center for Chrysler-Jeep-
3 Dodge; and

4 **WHEREAS**, despite the fact that the automotive industry is predominantly
5 male, Joyce has excelled in various capacities and with Joyce's involvement and
6 leadership, Cars Plus has grown exponentially into a business that offers service,
7 sales, and parts for Hyundai, Chrysler, Jeep, Dodge, Ram, GEM electric vehicles, and
8 other pre-owned vehicles; and

9 **WHEREAS**, having excelled in the automotive industry, Joyce has extended
10 her notable work ethic and passion towards her service within the island's community;
11 and

12 **WHEREAS**, Joyce gives back selflessly to her island community through her
13 charitable service and support to the following organizations and foundations: the
14 Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association; the Mount Carmel School
15 Foundation; the American Cancer Society; the Make-A-Wish Foundation; the Miss
16 Earth Pageant; the Guam Football Association; the Guam Table Tennis Federation;
17 the Smokin' Wheels race event; the Guam Humanities Council; the Edward M. Calvo
18 Cancer Foundation; and the Guam Diabetes Association, along with her active
19 participation in a multitude of other events and sponsorships; and

20 **WHEREAS**, additionally, Joyce Quinata Crisostomo serves as the Chairwoman
21 of the Make A Wish Foundation, the Guam Humanities Council, and the 2011 Table
22 Tennis Global Junior Circuit;, and also serves as a Member of the GMHA Volunteers

1 purchase equipment for the Guam Memorial Hospital; and as the Co-Chairperson for
2 the Inaugural Ball, Joyce helped to raise Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000) for
3 *Kamalen Karidat*; now therefore, be it

5 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Mrs. Joyce Q.
6 Crisostomo for having been selected and honored as the First Hawaiian Bank and

8 most sincere *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* for her continued, generous service
9 and strong, committed leadership to our island community; and does further commend
