Relative to recognizing the Domino Lux (DLX) International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, on the occasion of its Third (3rd) Year Anniversary celebration, and acknowledging that Domino Lux is one of the fastest growing local organizations on Guam, having increased its membership by more than five hundred fifty (550) members since its establishment; and to further extending *Un Dângkolo' Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* and *Maraming Salamat Po'* to all the brotherhood members for their active involvement throughout the island community, and their support for the people of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

1 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux (DLX) Fraternity is an elite international
2 fraternity established for the purposes of strategically focusing on the promotion of the
3 DLX core values of Brotherhood, Intellectual, Cultural, Physical and Spiritual
4 Welfare of its members; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux Fraternity was originally founded on September
6 20, 1974, at the De La Salle University in Manila, Philippines by fourteen (14)
7 aspiring professionals to extend the camaraderie amongst its members in college and
8 throughout life. Subsequently, one of the brothers established the Domino Lux
9 International Fraternity in an effort to share its legacy and values worldwide, and to
10 further promote the brotherhood in the advancement of personal and professional
11 success; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux Fraternity advocates and promotes the
13 symbolism of brotherhood, to include: encourage individualism within the framework
14 of cooperation; preserve lifetime friendship amongst its members; provide support and
15 encouragement in the personal and professional endeavors of its members; promote
16 the strength and foundation of the family as the core to a successful and fruitful life;
17 and promote the direct involvement of its members, and their participation, in the
18 support of local community activities; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux Fraternity's guiding principles center on the
20 following goals: (1) To promote the spirit of camaraderie among the members; (2) To
21 inculcate in every member the value of scholarship, and act as a guiding force in the
22 pursuit of chosen careers, and making every member fully prepared for his or her
23 current and future state; (3) To improve the social attitudes and conduct of each
24 member; (4) To provide a medium in developing and polishing the potential in every
25 member; (5) To develop the physical and mental well-being of each member; and (6)

1 To uplift spiritual awareness in every member to achieve a well rounded personality;

3 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, was
4 informally established on Guam on June 18, 2008, with eighteen (18) Chapter
5 Original Founding Members, and in just a short time span of three (3) years it has
6 grown its membership to more than five hundred fifty (550) brothers, which has been
7 credited much to the ability of each of its individual members to aggressively recruit
8 new members because of the organization's dynamic support internally of each other
9 and of its support to the island community; with the Guam Chapter being recognized
10 as the Domino Lux International Fraternity Headquarters; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, will
12 soon be venturing on expanding its foundational base to include the establishment of a
13 Domino Lux International Sorority, Guam, which will similarly promote and advocate
14 its core values and principles amongst the female population on island in the
15 advancement of sisterhood and community; and

16 **WHEREAS**, since its initial establishment, the Domino Lux International
17 Fraternity, Guam Chapter has extended tremendous support amongst its members and
18 the Guam community, to include, but not limited to, the following activities: regular
19 gatherings of its members for friendship; sponsoring the DLX Annual Red Carpet Ball
20 fundraiser to celebrate founding day amongst brothers and family members, with the
21 proceeds being distributed to several of Guam's non-profit community organizations;
22 participation of its members in numerous local sports activities, i.e. basketball,
23 softball, billiards, and others; regular family day gatherings; conducting an annual
24 religious retreat for its members during Lent; sponsoring sports clinics for the island's
25 youths; participating in the cleaning and painting of one of Guam's public middle
26 schools; providing monetary donations to the Japan Earthquake Relief Effort;

1 sponsoring medical fundraisers in support of family members; and numerous other
2 events and activities that highlight the active support and contributions that the
3 Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter provides to the people of Guam;
4 now therefore, be it

5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
7 of Guam, recognize, acknowledge and congratulate the Domino Lux International
8 Fraternity, Guam Chapter on the occasion of its Third (3rd) Year Anniversary
9 celebration, does extend best wishes for continued success in future endeavors; and
10 does further extend *Un Dângkolo' Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* and *Maraming Salamat Po'* in
11 appreciation to the Guam Chapter's Original Founding Members and each of the
12 members of the Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, for the support
13 they provide internally to its members and their families, and especially for their
14 overwhelming support and tremendous contributions to the island community during
15 the short time of the group's existence; and be it further


16 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


