Relative to recognizing and commending Congressman Florencio "Joeben" T. Miraflores of the Lone District of Aklan for his many achievements and accomplishments; and to further extending a sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'us Ma'ase*' to him for being the Guest Speaker at the Aklan Association of Guam Forty-sixth (46th) Year Anniversary celebration, and Induction of new Officers.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I

2 MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

- 1 WHEREAS, Congressman Florencio "Joeben" T. Miraflores was chosen by
- 2 the Aklan Association of Guam to be the Guest Speaker at their Forty-sixth (46th)
- 3 Year Anniversary celebration, and Induction of new Officers; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Congressman Miraflores, known as "Joeben" to his family,
- 5 friends and relatives, graduated from the De La Salle University with an Industrial and
- 6 Management Engineering Degree; and
- WHEREAS, prior to entering politics in 1988, Congressman Miraflores
- 8 worked with the Ministry of Human Settlements, where he served as the Area
- 9 Manager for Region VI; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Congressman Miraflores' parents are (†)Jose C. Miraflores and
- Eusebia T. Miraflores, and he is a native son of Ibajay; and
- WHEREAS, Congressman Miraflores is married to the former Ma. Lourdes V.
- 13 Martin, who is presently the Municipal Mayor of Ibajay, and together they have three
- 14 (3) children: Ma. Luisa Angeles, Jose Enrique and Jose Miguel; and
- WHEREAS, Aklan Congressman Florencio Tumbokon Miraflores served in
- 16 the Congress of the Philippines, bringing with him sixteen (16) years of solid
- 17 experience in local governance and public service; and
- 18 WHEREAS, for eight (8) years, from 1988 to 1995, Congressman Miraflores
- served as the Mayor of his hometown of Ibajay, where, during his incumbency, the
- 20 town was recognized as the Most Outstanding Municipal Government in the Province
- 21 of Aklan; and
- WHEREAS, in 1995, Congressman Miraflores was elected to serve as the
- 23 Governor of the Province of Aklan, a position he held for three (3) consecutive terms,
- 24 ending in 2004. It was during his term that Aklan experienced unprecedented
- economic growth, elevating the Province from fifth (5th) class to second (2nd) class
- status. He accomplished this by implementing an aggressive development program

anchored on improving the Province's core infrastructure network. Congressman

2 Miraflores understood that embarking on these ambitious projects required vast

resources and he had to resort to creative and innovative means of financing these

projects; and during his term, funds were sourced out from the National Government

for the improvements of the Kalibo and the Caticlan Airports; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Miraflores was also responsible for the rehabilitation and upgrading of the Dr. Rafael S. Tumbokon Memorial Hospital to tertiary category, under a loan-grant agreement with the LOGOFIND. Under this agreement, the Provincial Government would pay back only sixty percent (60%) of the total project cost at a fixed interest rate lower than commercial banks, while the remaining twenty percent (20%) is an outright grant, and the other twenty percent (20%) is equity of the Provincial Government. By entering into this agreement alone, Congressman Miraflores had saved the Provincial Government millions of pesos already; and believing in the skills and technical expertise of local engineers and architects, he further saved the Provincial Government a large sum of money by undertaking in-house the detailed engineering design, as well as the construction supervision of the whole project; and

WHEREAS, it was also through Congressman Miraflores' efforts that the Caticlan Jetty Port and Passenger Terminal were constructed, the funds for which were sourced out through a bond flotation, which was an innovative idea that no other LGU had used before. Though new and untested, then Governor Miraflores pursued this scheme to finance the project and it was a success. This project gave Aklan the distinction of being the first LGU to successfully issue provisional funds to fund a local project, and this experience is listed as one of the best practices of LGUs in local financing by the Bureau of Local Government Finance. Since then, a number of LGUs

have followed the Aklan bond flotation model; and

WHEREAS, today the Caticlan Jetty Port and Passenger Terminal is the top revenue earner for the Provincial Government of Aklan; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Miraflores' strong support of tourism helped Boracay Island win the *Kalakbay* Award for the Best Tourism Destination of the country in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Miraflores also led Aklan to receive another distinction: the National Honor Award on Nutrition, the highest award given to a Province for being a Consistent Regional Outstanding Winner in Nutrition (CROWN AWARD) for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, during his term as Governor, the Provincial Government computerized the Real Property Tax Management System (RPTMS) of the Provincial Assessor's Office (PAO). Though this project, the Province of Aklan was able to maximize real property revenue collection through a more efficient way of identifying and recording of both the delinquent and loyal taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, in 1998, Congressman Miraflores was elected to serve as the Chairman of the Regional Development Council (RDC) for Region VI, the first (1st) Aklanon Governor to chair this regional body. By the time Congressman Miraflores ended his term in 2001, the RDC had adopted the twin economic thrusts of agricultural and tourism development that he advocated; and

WHEREAS, after chairing the RDC, Congressman Miraflores went on to Chair the Regional Peace and Order Council (RPOC) for three (3) years, where he actively participated in implementing the Peace Agreement between the Government of the Republic of the Philippines (GRP) and the Rebolusyonaryong Partido ng Manggagawa-Proletarian Army-Alex Boncayao Brigade (RPM-RPA-ABB) in Western Visayas; and

1 WHEREAS, for all his accomplishments, the Honorable Florencio "Joeben" T. 2 Miraflores was recognized by the Asusasyon ng Kumentarista at Anaunser ng Pilipinas Manila as the Outstanding Governor in Region VI; and 3 WHEREAS, Congressman Miraflores is serving in his third (3rd) and final term 4 as Congressman of the Lone District of Aklan. He is the newly designated Chairman 5 6 of the Committee on Tourism; the Vice Chairman of the Committee on Accounts; and he is a Member of the Committee on Energy, the Committee on Appropriations, the 7 8 Committee on Natural Resources, the Committee on Ways and Means, the Committee 9 on Science and Technology, and the Committee on Local Government; now therefore, 10 be it 11 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 12 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, recognize and commend Congressman Florencio "Joeben" T. Miraflores for 13 14 his many achievements and accomplishments; and does further extend a sincere Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'us Ma'ase' to him for being the Guest Speaker at the Aklan 15 Association of Guam Forty-sixth (46th) Year Anniversary celebration and Induction of 16 new Officers; and be it further 17 18 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 19 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of 20 the same be thereafter transmitted to Congressman Florencio "Joeben" T.
