11 Oregon State University; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 1992, Colonel Wieder also attended Squadron Officers School
13 at Maxwell Air Force Base in Montgomery, Alabama; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Colonel Wieder has attended various seminars and has received
15 certifications from the Air Command and Staff College in 2000, and in 2004 from the
16 Air War College; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Colonel Wieder has been assigned to military posts all over the
18 world, including Korea, Japan, Iraq, and all throughout the United States; and

19 **WHEREAS**, during his many years of service, Colonel Alan J. Wieder has
20 received many major awards and decorations, including: the Bronze Star; the Air
21 Force Meritorious Service Medal; the Air Force Commendation Medal; the Air Force
