WHEREAS, fifty percent (50%) of the *Chamorro* population living in Florida 1 2 consists of service members from five (5) major military bases, which are NAS Pensacola, NAS Jacksonville, Eglin AFB, Tyndall AFB and McDill AFB, to include 3 4 retirees as well; and 5 WHEREAS, every year the Marianas *Chamorro* Community of Florida comes 6 together as one family to practice the custom of "Inafa' Maolek", and to instruct the 7 vounger generation on its true meaning; and 8 WHEREAS, the Marianas Chamorro Community of Florida promotes and 9 enhances the culture, traditions and the native language of the *Chamorro* people, as 10 well as the educational, cultural and social programs that foster its mission; and 11 WHEREAS, the Marianas *Chamorro* Community of Florida provides 12 assistance and support to the *Chamorro* community, both active and retired military, 13 as well as civilian; and 14 WHEREAS, the Marianas Chamorro Community of Florida will be a member-15 run organization, wherein the membership at large, rather than a board of trustees, 16 makes all major decisions; and 17 WHEREAS, the Marianas *Chamorro* Community of Florida comes together each year to celebrate an historic event to honor the fallen, as well as the survivors, 18 19 during the Liberation of Guam and the Northern Marianas; now therefore, be it **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 20 21 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the 22 people of Guam, highly commend and recognize the Marianas Chamorro Community of Florida on the celebration of their 2011 Liberation Day Festivities in 23 24 Titusville, Florida; and be it further **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 25
