WHEREAS, Sonia E. Blissett received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in
Psychology in 1980 from Cedar Crest College in Allentown, Pennsylvania; a Master

of Arts Degree in Applied Psychology in 1982 from Adelphi University in Garden
 City, New York; and her Doctor of Philosophy Degree in Clinical Psychology in 1994
 from Fairleigh Dickinson University in Teaneck, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, a Licensed Psychologist in both the State of New York and the
Territory of Guam, Dr. Blissett is also a member of the American Psychological
Association and the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development; and

WHEREAS, throughout her career, Dr. Blissett held various clinical and 7 8 administrative positions, including her appointment as a Group Therapist at Fairleigh 9 Dickinson University's Department of Psychology in Teaneck, New Jersey (1986); Psychology Intern at Hall-Brooke Hospital in Westport, Connecticut (1987-1988); 10 11 School Psychologist at Fordham Tremont Community Mental Health Clinic in Bronx, New York (1991-1992); Clinical Psychologist at United Cerebral Palsy of New York 12 13 City, New York (2005-2006); and Director of Clinical and Managerial Services for 14 Tamkeen Centre in Al Shaab Al Bahary, Kuwait (2006-2009); and

15 WHEREAS, Dr. Blissett also joined the field of teaching, serving as an instructor in the areas of child development, behavior modification in the classroom, 16 advanced behavior modification and social 17 educational psychology, skills 18 development. From 1982 to 1999, Dr. Blissett served as a faculty member at different centers, including Adelphi University in Garden City, New York; Fairleigh Dickinson 19 20 University in Teaneck, New Jersey; and at the Jeddah Autistic Center and the Al-Bir 21 Orphanage in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the array of services she provided as a consultant and clinical psychologist for both the State of New York and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Dr. Blissett also maintained her private practice in New York, and provided assessment, psychotherapy, and consultation services to school children throughout the state; and WHEREAS, in 2009, Dr. Blissett found her way to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse (DMHSA), where she was appointed as a Staff Psychologist to help provide comprehensive psychological assessments, diagnoses, and treatment evaluation services at a time when only three (3) psychologists were employed at the agency on a full-time basis; and

6 WHEREAS, Dr. Blissett agreed to a two (2) year employment contract under 7 the leadership of Dr. David Shimizu, and she would later assist the agency in 8 addressing various challenges that have long plagued the island's mental health 9 system of care, including the hiring of additional psychologists who, like her, shared 10 an impressive professional history; and

WHEREAS, together with the outstanding professional and support staff of DMHSA, Dr. Blissett worked diligently to improve various components of the agency, including the completion of multi-disciplinary treatment plans for clients, facilitation of individual, family and group therapy, and the improved networking of family members, service providers, and community groups; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Blissett also strived to integrate the various standards of care commonly found in similar health care facilities throughout the U.S. mainland. She brought with her tangible experiences that helped DMHSA improve the quality and delivery of health care services provided to individuals with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, in August 2011, the clients and staff of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse will bid farewell to Dr. Blissett as her tenure at the agency concludes, thus ending yet another exciting and productive example of Dr. Blissett's commitment to public service; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, commend Sonia Elaine Blissett, Ph.D., for the outstanding contributions she has made to the people of Guam as a Psychologist with the Department of Mental
Health and Substance Abuse; and does further extend a sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to Dr. Blissett for helping to improve the quality and delivery of health
care services provided to individuals with disabilities; and be it further
