2 School and Our Lady of Fatima Academy in Samar; and

3           **WHEREAS**, in 1959, Irene Salazar Carbon obtained her Dental Degree from  
4 Manila Central University Dental School; and

5           **WHEREAS**, on December 16, 1978, Irene Salazar Carbon moved to  
6 Guam, with her husband, Teodoro Carbon, and their children, Theresa and Jovito; and

7           **WHEREAS**, in 1985, Irene Salazar Carbon started working at the Department  
8 of Public Health and Social Services, where she served as a Dental Health Specialist  
9 at the *Inarajan* Public Health Center, and later transferred to the Central Public Health  
10 facility; and

11           **WHEREAS**, Irene Salazar Carbon had volunteered her services during times of  
12 natural disasters, to include helping the Food Stamp Program Staff issue emergency  
13 food stamps after Super Typhoons *Paka* (1997), *Chata'an* (2002) and *Pongsona*  
14 (2002); and

15           **WHEREAS**, Irene Salazar Carbon was awarded a Certificate of Appreciation  
16 for volunteering her services as a participant in the 2007 Guam Islandwide  
17 Immunization Coverage Assessment; and

18           **WHEREAS**, Irene Salazar Carbon was also recognized for her Outstanding  
19 Public Service to Chief Brodie Memorial Elementary School in 2010; and

20           **WHEREAS**, Irene Salazar Carbon received Outstanding Performance  
21 Evaluations in 1987, 1991 and 1992 for her exemplary work in the DPHSS Dental  
22 Program; now therefore, be it

24 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Irene Salazar Carbon on
