**BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

**WHEREAS**, the Twentieth (20<sup>th</sup>) Annual P.I.C. International Road Race will be held on Sunday, November 13, 2011, with participants from all over the Asia-Pacific Region; and

1       **WHEREAS**, what began as a 5K and 10K Fun Run in 1991, with only three  
2       hundred (300) runners participating, has now become one of Guam's most popular  
3       and sought after competitive races, attracting the most serious of runners from all  
4       over the region; and

5       **WHEREAS**, this event was voted by the Guam Visitors Bureau as the Most  
6       Outstanding Local Tourism Event for the year 2000; and

7       **WHEREAS**, since 1995, the PIC Road Races have enjoyed a sister-race  
8       relationship with the Fujiyoshida Fire Festival Road Race in Japan every August; and

9       **WHEREAS**, the top male and female finishers of the PIC Races are invited to  
10      the Fujiyoshida Race; and in return the top male and female finishers of the  
11      Fujiyoshida Race are invited to compete in the PIC Road Race; and

12      **WHEREAS**, a portion of this year's race proceeds will be donated to the  
13      Tourism Education Council (TEC), which was formed in 1988 to educate the  
14      community about the social and economic benefits that Guam's tourism industry  
15      provides; and whose mission is "Promoting the importance of the visitor industry with  
16      a special emphasis on the importance of sense of place"; now therefore, be it

17      **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
18      on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and highly commend the Pacific Islands  
19      Club Guam for its invaluable contributions to the people of Guam, and for hosting  
20      the PIC International Road Races for the past twenty (20) years; and be it further

21      **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,  
22      the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Pacific  
23      Islands Club Guam; to Shiegeru Sato; to Ralph Harrison; and to the Honorable  
24      Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
