**BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

**WHEREAS, SGS Guam, Inc., was established in 1989 to provide third (3<sup>rd</sup>) party inspection services for liquid fuels brought into Guam, and they currently have a workforce of seventeen (17) employees; and**

1       **WHEREAS**, SGS Guam, Inc., has since expanded their services to further  
2 support Guam's growth and development by providing inspection services for the  
3 island's hotel and tourism industry, the military establishment, and affiliated  
4 industries, for activities related to food services, and shipping and logistics services;

6       **WHEREAS**, SGS Guam, Inc., provides petroleum inspection, testing and  
7 metering services to clients who import and distribute petroleum products in the  
8 region, and its customers include: ExxonMobil, Shell, the United States Department  
9 of Defense Energy Supply Command, the South Pacific Petroleum Company, the  
10 Guam Power Authority, the Commonwealth Utilities Corporation, and the Majuro  
11 Electric Co. (RMI); and

12       **WHEREAS**, SGS Guam, Inc., is an engaged community partner and an active  
13 member of the Guam Chamber of Commerce, the Guam Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel Task  
14 Force, and the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association; and

15       **WHEREAS**, SGS Guam, Inc. was recognized by the Guam Chamber of  
16 Commerce in 2009 for having achieved twenty (20) years of business service in  
17 Guam; and

18       **WHEREAS**, SGS Guam, Inc., has attained International Organization for  
19 Standardization 9000 and 9001 certifications, by practicing and complying with  
20 internationally-recognized quality management practices and requirements,  
21 established to ensure they meet the needs of their customers and associated  
22 stakeholders; and

23       **WHEREAS**, SGS Guam, Inc., is a member of SGS, a business entity  
24 recognized as a global benchmark for quality inspection, verification, testing and  
25 certification services, with more than sixty-seven thousand (67,000) employees, and a

1 network of one thousand two hundred fifty (1,250) offices and laboratories located  
2 around the world; now therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
4 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend SGS Guam, Inc., for  
5 continuing to provide inspection services critical to the verification of liquid fuels and  
6 other consumer services; and does further extend a most sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si*  
7 *Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the company in recognition of over twenty (20) years of providing  
8 critical services to Guam and its people; and be it further
