Choi; Director for General 8 Affairs, Park Hyun Soo; Director for Finance, Charles J. Kim; Director for 9 Operations, Hyung Gon Kim; Director for Public Relations, Randy Jung; Director for 10 Sports, Jeon Tae Young; Director for Education, Jong Won Lee; Director for 11 Business, Simon Yi; Director for Medical, Alec S. Kim; Director for Senior Welfare 12 Won Suk Lee; and Director Peter Kang; and
