- WHEREAS, Daniel L. Robertson was born on October 1, 1946, in St. Louis,
- 4 Missouri; and

1 WHEREAS, as a young man Daniel was active with his church, the Boy 2 Scouts, 4-H clubs, sports, and student government; and his many interests included 3 hiking, photography, blacksmithing, and sailing, and he has traveled to locations such as Europe, the Middle East, the Far East, Africa and South America; and 4 WHEREAS, from 1965 to 1969, Daniel Robertson served in the military on 5 6 Active Duty as a Voice Intercept Processing Specialist for the United States Air Force 7 Security Service, where he completed intensive courses in Chinese Mandarin at the 8 Defense Language Institute; he worked in Okinawa and Taiwan as a translator; he held 9 Top Secret Cryptographic Security Clearance; and he was later honorably discharged 10 in November 1971; and WHEREAS, in 1972, Daniel received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in English 11 12 Language and Literature, and a Minor in Asian Studies, from Southern Illinois University, Edwardsville; in 1975, he received his Master of Arts Degree in Teaching 13 English as a Second Language from the University of Illinois, Urbana; and in 1983, he 14 15 received his Doctor of Philosophy in Education, also from the University of Illinois, Urbana; and 16 17 WHEREAS, in 1970, Daniel started his career in Education, serving as a Tutor in English at Southern Illinois University, where he tutored disadvantaged students in 18 19 reading and composition; and 20 WHEREAS, Daniel later worked in various positions, such as: Instructor in English as a Second Language; Graduate Research Assistant and Assistant Director 21 22 for the Office of Overseas Projects & Foreign Visitors at the University of Illinois in 23 Urbana: Project Staff Instructor and Assistant Professor at the University of Southern California in Los Angeles; Training Specialist for the Northrop Corporation in Saudi 24

1 Arabia; and as Director of the Intensive English Language Institute at the University

2 of North Texas in Denton; and

WHEREAS, in August 1989, Dr. Daniel Robertson started his education career on Guam at the University of Guam (UOG), where he taught courses in English as a Second Language (ESL), Composition, ESL Teaching Methodology, Linguistics and Language Testing; he also directed the English Language Institute from 1989 to 1997; and

WHEREAS, while on Guam, Dr. Daniel Robertson further embraced the culture of Guam and its people by learning the *Chamorro* language. He has called Guam his home for more than twenty (20) years, and has become a staple at the Division of English and Applied Linguistics of the University of Guam; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Daniel Robertson's retirement leaves a void that will be extremely difficult to fill, as former University of Guam students refer to him as "challenging but extremely passionate and unforgettable," and some of his colleagues describe him as "great, caring and professional," and as someone who has devoted so much in the field of English, Linguistics and Education; now therefore, be it
