- 5 Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., is now licensed to do business on Guam, and it also
- 6 serves the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and American Samoa; and

WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., serves its clients by creating technology-based solutions in three (3) key areas: information technology, software engineering, and custom application solutions; and Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., has since expanded to include human resources services, such as staffing, consulting, training and development, and drug testing; and

WHEREAS, the mission of Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., is to provide the highest quality service, utilizing the latest methods and technology available while minimizing costs; providing on-time performance, and improving efficiencies and effectiveness for the organizations and clients it serves; and

WHEREAS, the cadre of professionals of Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., have over twenty-eight (28) years of experience managing various multi-million dollar projects and multi-year contracts for federal, state and territorial governments, as well as the private sector; and

WHEREAS, the experiences of Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., include working with federal grants in the administration, implementation and compliance of various government programs, i.e. transportation, education, finance, housing, and labor; and

WHEREAS, the initial engagement of Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., on Guam began in 2004 with the Department of Public Works (DPW) and the Office of Highway Safety (OHS). The grant applications prepared by Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., have provided over Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars

(\$2,800,000) to DPW and OHS; and

WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., recently installed an Electronic Citation System for GPD and the Superior Court of Guam. This system allows a GPD Officer to issue an electronic traffic violation in a police car and transmit the data over a wireless network through the Government of Guam Wide Area Network (GGWAN) to the Superior Court Database at the Department of Administration (DOA). With the system being successful, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., has been awarded a three (3) years extension on its current contract; and

WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc., in recognizing the opportunities and the potential of the Pacific region, decided to open Ledge Light Technologies Pacific, with the appointment of Ms. Zita Pangelinan as its Chief Operating Officer for the Pacific region; and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2011, Ledge Light Technologies Pacific will have a Grand Opening at its new office located at the GCIC Building, Suite 701, West Soledad Avenue, *Hagatna*, Guam; now therefore, be it
