- 1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

3        **WHEREAS,** the Rotary Club of Northern Guam was established on November  
4        12, 1975, and currently has a membership of thirty-six (36) dedicated, community-  
5        oriented Guam residents; and

1       **WHEREAS**, the mission of Rotary International, the parent organization of  
2       which the Rotary Club of Northern Guam is a Charter member within District 2750, is  
3       to provide service to others, to promote integrity, and to advance world understanding,  
4       goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional, and community  
5       leaders; and

6       **WHEREAS**, the Rotary Club of Northern Guam has consistently fulfilled this  
7       mission by contributing to our island community in positive ways over the past thirty-  
8       six (36) years, to include providing students with scholarships to attend the University  
9       of Guam and the Guam Community College, and developing numerous community  
10      projects not only on Guam, but also throughout Micronesia and the larger Asia-Pacific  
11      region; and

12      **WHEREAS**, the Rotary Peace Community Program is an international  
13      initiative to develop alliances between local Rotary Clubs, community leaders, local  
14      governments, and other community agencies in making a declaration of Community  
15      Peace; and

16      **WHEREAS**, following the tragic events of September 11, 2001, the Rotary  
17      Club of Northern Guam committed itself to developing a Peace Memorial to  
18      memorialize and honor the many lives that were lost; and in the spirit of the Rotary  
19      Peace Community Program, to serve as a healing monument of Community Peace;

21      **WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2002, the Rotary Club of Northern Guam,  
22      under then President Ed Cruz, held a groundbreaking ceremony for the Peace  
23      Memorial to be located at Two Lover's Point; and

25      its Peace Memorial to honor all the lives that were lost and impacted by the events of
