3       **WHEREAS**, since its creation, Sanctuary, Incorporated, has remained at the  
4 forefront of providing comprehensive services to runaway, homeless and troubled  
5 youth, and their families; and they are continually expanding the scope of their  
6 services to the local population, and are addressing the emergent issues that our local  
7 youth face; and

8       **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated, continuously strives to provide support  
9 programs, that now include a Twenty-four (24) Hour Crisis Hotline; a Coed  
10 Emergency Shelter; the Rural Host Homes Demonstration Project; the Transitional  
11 Living Program, *Sagan Na’Homlo Para I Manhoben*, for youth battling chemical  
12 dependency; Case Management Services; the *Ayuda Para I Komunidat* AmeriCorps  
13 Program; the Street Outreach Program; the Relationship Intelligence Project; the  
14 Youth Embracing Sanctuary (YES) Crew Positive Youth Development Program; the  
15 *Fan Macho’cho* Economic Development-Aquaculture and Healing Farms Organic  
16 Farming Project; the Parenting Skills and Support Group; Adult Anger Management,  
17 Youth Anger Management programs; a Tobacco Cessation program; Self Esteem,  
18 Drug and Alcohol Education and Treatment groups; and HIV/STD testing and  
19 education; and

20       **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated, encourages island residents to join in  
21 various events throughout the month of November 2011 to help educate others about  
22 Sanctuary’s services; and


23       **WHEREAS**, November 2011 will mark the Fortieth (40th) Year Anniversary
