WHEREAS, the *U.S. Explore and Study, Inc.* has been instrumental in trying to heal the wounds of World War II, and the tensions over the war between the people of Guam, Japan and the United States; and it has held ceremonies and tributes in past years with that noble aim; and

WHEREAS, the *U.S. Explore and Study, Inc.*, along with its President, Mr. Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals, and especially to help organize this trip by Japanese high school students; now therefore, be it
