WHEREAS, it has been recognized that each person in our community plays one (1) of three (3) roles with regards to bullying: being either the bully, the bullied, or the bystander who observes the act; and further recognizing that the bystander who does not become involved in discouraging bullying behavior enables the behavior to continue, and they should be educated about the importance of their role in the prevention of bullying; and

WHEREAS, Guam seeks to educate and raise awareness of bullying prevention efforts by engaging our island's youth to become more active participants in bullying prevention measures, such as the First (1st) BASTA (Bullying Affects Students, Teachers, and ALL) Bullying Prevention Poster competition; and

WHEREAS, members of the Judiciary of Guam and the Department of Education, along with community partners and concerned citizens, have joined together to engage our youth in positive activities and provide educational outreach programs aimed at reducing bullying in our communities; now therefore, be it
