## 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

3 WHEREAS, Guam has joined with communities across the United States in 4 the observance of "National Bullying Prevention Month" during the month of

October, in order to promote bullying prevention within our schools and community, 1 2 and to support the needs of children; and

3 WHEREAS, it has been shown that community involvement is critical in effectively reducing the occurrences of bullying, and in encouraging more acceptable 4 5 behaviors from our children, through the education and promotion of positive 6 behavioral alternatives to bullying; and

7 WHEREAS, it has been recognized that each person in our community plays one (1) of three (3) roles with regards to bullying: being either the bully, the bullied, 8 9 or the bystander who observes the act; and further recognizing that the bystander who does not become involved in discouraging bullying behavior enables the behavior to 10 11 continue, and they should be educated about the importance of their role in the 12 prevention of bullying; and

13 WHEREAS, Guam seeks to educate and raise awareness of bullying prevention efforts by engaging our island's youth to become more active participants 14 in bullying prevention measures, such as the First (1<sup>st</sup>) BASTA (Bullying Affects 15 16 Students, Teachers, and ALL) Bullying Prevention Poster competition; and

WHEREAS, members of the Judiciary of Guam and the Department of 17 18 Education, along with community partners and concerned citizens, have joined 19 together to engage our youth in positive activities and provide educational outreach 20 programs aimed at reducing bullying in our communities; now therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 22 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, recognize and commend Geoffrey Gersaniba for his achievements and his 23 commitment to being a part of the solution to prevent bullying on Guam by his 24 25 participation in the BASTA Bullying Prevention Poster competition, and subsequently winning the First (1<sup>st</sup>) Place Award in his category; and be it further 26
