## 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

3 WHEREAS, Guam has joined with communities across the United States in 4 the observance of "National Bullying Prevention Month" during the month of

1 October, in order to promote bullying prevention within our schools and community, 2 and to support the needs of children; and

3 WHEREAS, it has been shown that community involvement is critical in effectively reducing the occurrences of bullying, and in encouraging more acceptable 4 5 behaviors from our children, through the education and promotion of positive 6 behavioral alternatives to bullying; and

7 WHEREAS, it has been recognized that each person in our community plays 8 one (1) of three (3) roles with regards to bullying: being either the bully, the bullied, 9 or the bystander who observes the act; and further recognizing that the bystander who 10 does not become involved in discouraging bullying behavior enables the behavior to continue, and they should be educated about the importance of their role in the 11 12 prevention of bullying; and

WHEREAS, Guam seeks to educate and raise awareness of bullying 13 prevention efforts by engaging our island's youth to become more active participants 14 in bullying prevention measures, such as the First (1<sup>st</sup>) BASTA (Bullying Affects 15 Students, Teachers, and ALL) Bullying Prevention Poster competition; and 16

17 WHEREAS, members of the Judiciary of Guam and the Department of Education, along with community partners and concerned citizens, have joined 18 19 together to engage our youth in positive activities and provide educational outreach 20 programs aimed at reducing bullying in our communities; now therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 22 23 of Guam, recognize and commend Aila Cassandra Rodriguez for her achievements 24 and her commitment to being a part of the solution to prevent bullying on Guam by her participation in the BASTA Bullying Prevention Poster competition, and 25 subsequently winning the Second  $(2^{nd})$  Place Award in her category; and be it further 26
