## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I

- 2 MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:
- WHEREAS, the late Jeff David T. Barcinas was born on January 18, 1956, one
- 4 (1) of the five (5) children of the late Jose Cruz Barcinas and the late Rita Tajalle
- 5 Tainatongo of Malesso; and

1 WHEREAS, Jeff was baptized in February of 1956 at the San Dimas Catholic 2 Church in *Malesso*; he received his First Holy Communion at Mt. Carmel Catholic 3 Church in Agat; and he was confirmed at the San Dimas Catholic Church in Malesso 4 on March 13, 1964, by the late Bishop Apollinaris Baumgartner, OFM Cap. D.D.; and 5 WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff attended Inarajan Elementary School for 6 kindergarten; he received his elementary and middle school education from Mt. Carmel Catholic School in Agat; and then attended Father Duenas Memorial School, 7 8 where he graduated in 1974; and 9 WHEREAS, Jeff attended the University of Guam from 1974 to 1976, and then 10 transferred to California State Polytechnic University in Pomona, California, where he graduated in June 1979 with a Bachelor of Science Degree, with an emphasis in 11 12 agricultural economics and crop production; and WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff then received a Master of Arts Degree from 13 14 Washington State University in 1981, with an emphasis in farm management and agricultural development. His master's project was the Small Farm Record Book 15 16 System that was eventually published as a Cooperative Extension Manual; and 17 WHEREAS, in 1989, Deacon Jeff became a Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) at the Ohio State University, with an emphasis in extension education, research and 18 statistics, administration in higher education, and evaluation; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Jeff began working at the University of Guam in 1979 as an Extension Agent of the College of Agriculture and Life Science, teaching different 21 22 agriculture courses and providing information and informal educational programs to farmers and residents of Guam, and also served in various roles at the University; and 23 24 WHEREAS, from 1992 to 1995, Deacon Jeff served as the Associate Dean of the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, where he assisted in the management of 25

the Cooperative Extension Service programs, and where he was directly responsible

- 1 for the core programs, the budget, the organizational structure, and the personnel.
- 2 Later on Jeff became the Dean and Director of the College until 2003, where he
- 3 provided leadership, direction and supervision over the academic programs, research
- 4 activities and outreach functions; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff had also served as the Acting Academic Vice-
- 6 President in 2000; and as the Acting Associate Vice-President of Enrollment
- 7 Management and Student Services, from 2002 to 2003; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff became the Vice-President of the University and
- 9 Community Engagement, and the Director of Cooperative Extension Service in 2003;
- and he retired from these positions in December of 2008. While serving in these
- positions, Jeff established the new initiative of the engagement program of the
- 12 University of Guam, and focused on strengthening local and federal relations and
- partnering with national and regional organizations to increase revenue opportunities
- 14 for the University of Guam; and
- WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff was the Personal Secretary of the Metropolitan
- 16 Archbishop of Agana, the Most Reverend Anthony Sablan Apuron, OFMCap.D.D;
- and he was also the official spokesperson of the Archdiocese of Agana; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff's pastoral experiences included serving as the
- 19 Liturgical Commission Technical Writer for Liturgical Guidelines for Baptism, RCIA,
- 20 Confirmation, and Matrimony (1999 to 2001); serving as the Deacon Assistant of the
- 21 Parishes of San Dimas and San Dionisio (August 16, 2003 to present); and serving as
- 22 the Archdiocese of Agana Sexual Abuse Response Coordinator (March 2010 to
- present); and
- WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff was a recipient of several awards, such as the
- 25 Director Emeritus Western Association of Cooperation Extension Directors (March
- 26 2008); the NASULGC Plaque of Recognition for Service as a member of the

- 1 Extension Committee on Organization and Policy (November 2007); the Top Ten
- 2 Donor Award, University of Guam Endowment Foundation (2007); the Lifetime
- 3 Donor Award, University of Guam Endowment Foundation (2002); nominated and
- 4 selected as the International Distinguished Scientific Leader (2002); nominated and
- 5 selected as the Outstanding Young Man of America (1981 and 1989); inducted to the
- 6 Chi Omicron Gamma Honorary Fraternity, UOG (1990); inducted to the Gamma
- 7 Sigma Delta Agricultural Honorary Fraternity of the Ohio State University Beta
- 8 Chapter (1988); and he was nominated for Who's Who in Guam in the Twentieth
- 9 (20<sup>th</sup>) Century (1990); and
- 10 WHEREAS, on October 15, 2011, relatives, friends, parishioners, and the
- whole Archdiocese of Agana mourned on the passing of Deacon Jeff, who will always
- be remembered for his compassion and dedication to the people of Guam; now
- therefore, be it

- 15 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people

- 17 the late Deacon Jeff David T. Barcinas for his dedication and service to the people of
- 18 Guam; and does further extend condolences to his family on his passing; and be it
