- 10 WHEREAS, Dr. Iris HeavyRunner-PrettyPaint has a Bachelor's Degree in
- 11 Social Work from the University of Kansas, and a Master's Degree and Doctorate in
- 12 Social Work from the University of Minnesota, and she is a recognized educator,

- dedicated to community-based education, advocacy and prevention, and she serves as
- a member of the American Indian Graduate Center's Honorary Advisory Council of

- 19 Director for Native Aspirations, a National Department of Health and Human
