- of Community Matters (CM), a California-based nonprofit organization whose
- 12 mission is to engage, equip, and empower young people to be contributors and
- peacemakers in their schools and communities; and

- programs, such as the Today Show and CNN, and in print, radio, and regional and
- 16 national interview programs as an expert in violence prevention and empowering

- 19 the books, "Ten Years after Columbine: School Violence-Prevention Report Card"
- 20 and "Safe School Ambassadors: Harnessing Student Power to Stop Bullying and

- WHEREAS, Mr. Rick Phillips, MS Ed. is the creator and co-developer of the
- 23 Safe School Ambassadors program, a youth-centered, violence prevention program
- 24 that has been implemented in more than nine hundred (900) schools in the United
