- WHEREAS, Guam seeks to educate and raise awareness of bullying
- 8 prevention efforts through specific events like the first (1st) BASTA Bullying
- 9 Prevention Conference; and
- 10 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Charles P.E. Leitch is an attorney, and the founding principal
- of Patterson, Buchanan, Fobes, Leitch & Kalzer, with over fifteen (15) years of
- 12 experience in litigation; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Charles P.E. Leitch provides legal counseling on the
- 14 prevention and response to harassment, intimidation, and bullying (HIB), both
- personal and cyberbullying; as well as effective supervision of technology and social
- media in the workplace and educational settings, and in technology privacy issues;
