- 1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***  
3        **WHEREAS,** Guam has joined with communities across the United States in  
4        the observance of “National Bullying Prevention Month” during the month of

1 October, in order to promote bullying prevention within our schools and community,  
2 and to support the needs of children; and

3 **WHEREAS**, it has been shown that community involvement and education is  
4 critical in effectively reducing the occurrences of bullying, and in encouraging more  
5 acceptable behavior from our children, through the promotion of positive behavioral  
6 alternatives to bullying; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Guam seeks to educate and raise awareness of bullying  
8 prevention efforts through specific events like the first (1<sup>st</sup>) BASTA Bullying  
9 Prevention Conference; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Terry L. Dozier is a retired National Basketball Association  
11 (NBA) player who was recruited from the University of South Carolina to play with  
12 the Charlotte Hornets of the NBA; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Terry L. Dozier had overcome the adversity of coming from  
14 an impoverished childhood to become an internationally-recognized role model for  
15 children and young athletes by using his accomplishments as an example of how  
16 obstacles can be overcome through hard work and dedication; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Terry Dozier's life experiences have shaped his personal  
18 philosophies and instilled in him a genuine concern for his fellow man, and a desire to  
19 share the knowledge he has gained through his experiences; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Terry L. Dozier has used his celebrity status to participate in  
21 educational outreach and motivational speaking for the purpose of encouraging others  
22 to engage in positive behaviors that will result in improved circumstances for society;


24 **WHEREAS**, members of the Judiciary of Guam and the Guam Department of
