Relative to recognizing and commending the Federation of Pangasinanses of Guam for their invaluable contributions and humanitarian assistance to the people of Guam and the Philippines; and to further bestowing on them the status of "Honorary Goodwill Ambassador-At-Large" of the people of Guam, as they embark on their Medical Mission to the Province of Pangasinan, Republic of the Philippines.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

3 **WHEREAS**, the Federation of Pangasinanses of Guam was officially founded 4 on February 10, 2002, at the request of various individuals, groups and families from 5 the Province of Pangasinan in the Philippines, for the purpose of creating an organization whose main mission is to create a friendship of camaraderie among those
 from the Province of Pangasinan with the people of their adopted new home of Guam;
 and

WHEREAS, the organization contributes to an annual endowment fund, in the form of an annual Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) scholarship, and an annual gift of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to both institutions of higher learning on Guam, the University of Guam and the Guam Community College, as well as donating twenty (20) annual scholarships to students chosen from each college by the Federation of Pangasinanses of Guam; and

10 WHEREAS, the Federation of Pangasinanses of Guam has made more than 11 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) in charitable contributions to various non-profit groups, such as civic, educational, cultural and religious 12 13 organizations, and humanitarian agencies with affiliations in Guam, the United States, and other organizations within the Republic of the Philippines, including the 14 American Red Cross, the American Cancer Society, the Make-A-Wish Foundation, 15 16 the Diabetes Association of Guam, numerous Guam and Philippines sports organizations and federations, the Hope Foundation; People Helping People, the 17 18 Metropolitan Archdiocese of Agaña, and the various Lions Clubs of Guam; and they 19 have provided medical assistance to countless individuals; and

WHEREAS, in November 2004, the Federation of Pangasinanses of Guam was designated as an "Honorary Goodwill Ambassador At-Large" of Guam as part of its first (1st) "Foreign Surgical and Medical Mission" to the Province of Pangasinan, in which they donated Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) worth of medicines and medical supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Officers, Board of Directors and Members of the Federation 1 of Pangasinanses of Guam will be conducting their second (2^{nd}) "Foreign Surgical and 2 3 Medical Mission" in November 2011; and

WHEREAS, the large amount of medicines and medical supplies that are being 4 5 donated to the people of the Province of Pangasinan during the "Foreign Surgical and Medical Mission" that will take place from November 12 to 26, 2011, are a gift from 6 the people of Guam that was made possible through the fundraising efforts of the 7 8 Federation of Pangasinanses of Guam; and

WHEREAS, for these and many other humanitarian endeavors undertaken by 9 10 this organization, I Liheslaturan Guåhan (the Guam Legislature) recognizes and 11 designates the Federation of Pangasinanses of Guam as an "Honorary Goodwill 12 Ambassador-At-Large," as it fulfills its "Foreign Surgical and Medical Mission" to assist the people of the Province of Pangasinan, Republic of the Philippines; now 13 14 therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 15 Liheslaturan Guåhan (the 31^{st} Guam Legislature) does hereby, on behalf of I 16 Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, recognize and commend the Federation 17 18 of Pangasinanses of Guam for its invaluable contributions and humanitarian assistance to the people of Guam and the Philippines; and does further bestow the title of 19 Guam's "Honorary Goodwill Ambassador-At-Large" status on the federation its as 20 embarks on its second (2nd) "Foreign Surgical and Medical Mission" to the Province 21 of Pangasinan, Republic of the Philippines; and be it further 22
