- 3 WHEREAS, Dr. Martesio C. Perez earned his Doctor of Medicine degree from
- 4 the College of Medicine of the University of Philippines, and he was ranked in the top
- 5 ten percent (10%) of his class; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez accomplished his post graduate training as a Resident in Medicine at the University of the Philippines-Philippine General Hospital Medical Center; as a Resident in Neurology at the University of Wisconsin Hospital; as a Chief Resident of the Department of Neurology at the University of Wisconsin Hospital; as a Resident in Neurology at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Madison, Wisconsin; as a Fellow in Medicine of the China Medical Board of New York; as a Fellow in Neuropathology at the Columbia Presbyterian Medical School; as a Research Fellow in Neurology at the University of Pennsylvania Hospital; as a Diplomat of the American

Board of Neurology, and as a Fellow of the Philippine Board of Neurology; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez is a Professor Emeritus of Neuroscience at the University of the Philippines; a Consultant to the Department of Neuroscience at the University of the Philippines-Philippines General Hospital Medical Center and Makati Medical Center; a member of the Advisory Council of the Brain Foundation of the Philippines; and an adviser to the Multiple Sclerosis Society of the Philippines, and the Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis Society of the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez is a pioneer in the organization of the first formal Residency Training Program in Neurology in the Philippines at the University of the Philippines—Philippines General Hospital Medical Center, in 1973; and in 1980, he organized the formation of the Makati Medical Center Residency Training Program; and

WHERERAS, Dr. Perez is one (1) of the twelve (12) founding members who actively sought to organize and integrate Neurologists from various universities in the Philippines, resulting in the formation of the Philippine Neurological Association of the Philippines, in 1972; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez was also instrumental in integrating the Sections of Neurology (Department of Medicine), Neurosurgery (Department of Surgery), and Neurophysiology (Department of Physiology), which were integrated under one (1) umbrella through the formation of the Department of Neurosciences, University of the Philippines; and Dr. Perez's efforts were recognized and honored by his appointment to serve as the first Chairman of the Department of Neurosciences, where he served from 1999 to 2001; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez was actively involved in transforming the Neuroscience curriculum into the problem-based and integrated curriculum that it presently is; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez's empathy for the plight of his patients, especially those with grave conditions, engendered him to organize support groups composed of family members, patients and neurologists. Thus were the following societies formed: the Myasthenia Gravis Society of the Philippines; the Multiple Sclerosis Society of the Philippines; the Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Society of the Philippines; and the Philippines League Against Epilepsy (PLAE). The PLAE is the national chapter of the International League Against Epilepsy, and is now recognized as the expert source of information and continuing professional education in the care of persons with epilepsy. The organization has also successfully implemented projects bringing epilepsy to the grass roots, a vision that is continuously and actively being pursued; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez recognized the need to give financial assistance to indigent patients of Neurology at the University of the Philippines-Philippines General Hospital Medical Center, and the need to give financial support for Neurology and Neurosurgery graduates in their pursuit of subspecialty training here and abroad, and the need to establish a Neuroscience Library; and
