3 **WHEREAS,** the Jamaican Grill Restaurant opened its first store at the Chamorro
4 Village in December 1994 and has been serving the people of Guam “Ya Mon, Serious
5 Food” for eighteen (18) years; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the special spices used in Jamaican Grill “Jerk” chicken and ribs
2 proved extremely popular, leading the management to open a second restaurant in
3 November 2004 in the Tumon tourist district; and

4 **WHEREAS**, based on the overwhelming success of the Jamaican Grill
5 Restaurants, the management decided to offer the delicious chicken and ribs (among
6 other tasty items on the menu) to the people of the north and opened a third store in the
7 village of Dededo on November 16, 2011; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Jamaican Grill Restaurant is extremely thankful to its
9 customers and gives back to the community by offering lunch plate fundraisers to
10 various non-profit organizations; and

11 **WHEREAS**, to further give back to the community, every year on September 11,
12 the Jamaican Grill gives free commemorative lunches to active Guam Police
13 Department officers and Guam Fire Department firefighters to acknowledge the work
14 they do to protect our community; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Jamaican Grill Restaurant with its “Ya Mon Serious Food” is
16 the brainchild of Frank Kenny and Tim Murphy, who have shown great commitment to
17 providing good food and service to the people of Guam; now therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*
19 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
20 of Guam, recognize and congratulate the Jamaican Grill Restaurant Staff and
21 Management on the occasion of their Grill Lighting Ceremony and opening of their
22 third (3rd) restaurant on Guam; and be it further
