3 experiences across borders, and encourages them to participate in international
4 education and exchange so they can gain the knowledge and experiences to help them
5 contribute to our island's economic competitiveness and security; and


6 **WHEREAS**, the need to provide all of our students with educational

14 and international exchange; now therefore, be it


15 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*

24 Board; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


