- 7 Camacho and Marcella Lieto Norita Camacho. He is married to Attorney Viola
- 8 Alepuyo, and they have a son, Ulen Joseph Vicente Alepuyo Camacho; and

1 WHEREAS, Judge Joseph Norita Camacho graduated from Marianas High School in 1987, and went on to earn his Associate of Arts Degree from the Northern 2 Marianas College in 1992, and his Bachelor of Arts Degree in History from San Jose 3 State University in 1994. He then continued in his studies and obtained a Master's 4 Degree in Public Administration from Seattle University in 1998, and obtained his 5 6 Juris Doctorate from Gonzaga University School of Law in 2001; and 7 WHEREAS, Judge Joseph Norita Camacho is admitted to practice law in the U.S. Supreme Court, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth (9th) Circuit, the U.S. 8 9 District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands, and the Commonwealth Courts; and WHEREAS, in 2008, Judge Joseph Norita Camacho was elected to serve in the 10 Seventeenth (17th) CNMI House of Representatives, and he was unanimously chosen 11 12 by his colleagues to serve as the Floor Leader; and 13 WHEREAS, Judge Joseph Norita Camacho led one of the largest law practices 14 in the CNMI during his practice, and had been one of the Commonwealth's leading 15 criminal defense attorneys for over ten (10) years before his appointment to the bench; 16 and WHEREAS, I Liheslaturan Guahan is proud to recognize and commend 17 Governor Benjamin Repeki Fitial of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana 18 19 Islands for his nomination of the Honorable Joseph Norita Camacho to serve in the 20 Superior Court; as well as the CNMI House of Representatives and Senate, who voted 21 unanimously to confirm the nomination of Joseph Norita Camacho to the Superior 22 Court of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and 23 WHEREAS, Judge Joseph Norita Camacho's vocation and dedication as an 24 attorney and a public servant has been rooted in his pursuit of social, economic and environmental justice for the people of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana 25 26 Islands; and
