3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Luis Golez Arguelles was born on March 8, 1933, in Jaro, Iloilo,
4 Philippines, and is the son of the late Antonio and Natividad Arguelles; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Arguelles grew up in Jaro, Iloilo, with his siblings, Celia A.
6 Cabaluna, Rafael Arguelles, Enrique Arguelles, Ramon Arguelles, and Pilar Arguelles; and

7 **WHEREAS**, on March 3, 2012, Dr. Arguelles will celebrate his fifty (50) years of
8 marriage with Catalina Sobremonte Arguelles. They were both blessed with five (5)
9 children: Arthur Louis Arguelles, Beatrice Anne Arguelles Santos, Cesar Antonio Arguelles,

1 David Joseph Arguelles, and Esther Arguelles; and are also blessed with seven (7)

3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Arguelles attended the University of Santo Tomas in the Philippines
4 for his medical school courses, and went on to receive medical training at the Good

6 residency in Pathology, and one (1) year residency in General Practice at the Montgomery
7 Hospital in Norristown, Pennsylvania, from 1961 to 1962. He also spent two (2) years of
8 residency in General Practice at the St. Anne's Hospital in Fall River, Massachusetts, from
9 1962 to 1964; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1964, Dr. Arguelles started his private practice in the Philippines; and
11 he then moved to Guam in 1966, where he served as a member of the Guam Memorial
12 Hospital Medical Staff, as well as the Department of Public Health; and

13 **WHEREAS**, from 1970 to 1972, Dr. Arguelles did his private practice at the Catholic
14 Medical Center, and then started serving his patients at the Marianas Medical Clinic &
15 Polyclinic, from 1974 to 1978; and

16 **WHEREAS**, from 1978 until his retirement, Dr. Arguelles took care of his patients at
17 the Trade Center Medical Clinic in *Tamuning*, where he helped numerous residents with
18 their medical needs and treatments; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Arguelles is an active member of the Saint Anthony Church
20 Eucharistic Ministry, and the Cursillos in Christianity. He is also involved in several projects
21 with a number of organizations, such as the American Medical Association, the Guam
22 Medical Society, and the Guam Medical Association; and

23 **WHEREAS**, when he is not attending to his patients' medical needs, Dr. Arguelles
24 loves to play tennis, walk, travel, and play with his grandkids; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Arguelles will be sorely missed by his colleagues, his patients, and
26 his friends, who wish him all the best on his retirement; now therefore, be it

28 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize


1 and congratulate Dr. Luis Golez Arguelles on the occasion of his retirement; does extend *Un*

8 Calvo, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.


