3 **WHEREAS, Ms. Lourdes “Queen Lulubelle” V. Bautista was born on**
4 **February 10, 1963, and is the daughter of †Peter and Pilar Bautista; Ms. Bautista and**
5 **her family are from the beautiful village of *Barrigada*; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Bautista began her government service with the Guam
2 Community College on June 14, 1982, where she worked as a Clerk Typist III; and
3 she later served as a Word Processing Secretary II from August 20, 1986, to
4 November 7, 1988, when she became an Administrative Secretary II, the position
5 from which she now retires; and

6 **WHEREAS**, during her time as an employee with the Guam Community
7 College, Ms. Bautista had displayed exemplary service, not only to the students, staff
8 and faculty, but to the Board of Trustees and the Foundation Board of Governors as
9 well; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Bautista has set a good example of someone with a “Can Do”
11 attitude, and one who works as a “Team Player”, and she will be truly missed; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in addition to her service with our government, Ms. Bautista has
13 also dedicated her time in service to the Santa Teresita Church Parish community in
14 *Mangilao*, where she has served in various active roles, including as the Secretary of
15 the Parish Social Committee, from 2000 to 2008; as the Chairperson of the New
16 Church, Same Spirit Coin Drive Program, from 2003 to 2009; and as a Member of the
17 Parish Social Committee, from 2009 to the present; and

19 as she does in her professional life, through her help as the family’s Chief Information
20 Officer, serving as a central communications hub for over five hundred (500)
21 individuals, sharing information such as births, deaths, celebrations, calls for prayers,

25 on the occasion of her retirement; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu’os*


1 *Ma'ase* to her for dedicating twenty-nine (29) years and six (6) months of exemplary
