WHEREAS, the bond between the people of Guam and the people of the Republic of the Philippines has grown stronger over the years, as the two (2) neighbors in the Western Pacific Ocean share many of the same influences, both political and cultural; and

WHEREAS, a number of Guam's residents can trace their roots back to
the Philippines, and specifically to the Province of Pangasinan in Luzon, which
is often referred to as the "heartland of the Philippines;" and

WHEREAS, the people of Guam, along with our brothers and sisters from the Republic of Philippines, and especially those from the Province of Pangasinan, share more commonalities than differences, and together we can better prepare for a future of unprecedented opportunities towards the sustained growth of our communities; and

6 WHEREAS, the relationship between the good neighbors on both sides 7 of the Philippine Sea was further strengthened when the Federation of 8 Pangasinanses on Guam was recently recognized by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, 9 and were designated as "Honorary Goodwill Ambassadors-At-Large" for the 10 people of Guam as they embarked on their important Medical Mission to the 11 Province of Pangasinan to help the impoverished people living in small towns 12 in the Province who are unable to afford medical care; and

WHEREAS, with the good people of both Guam and Pangasinan finding common ground, working together, assisting each other, and helping to make the most of future opportunities, the official establishment of a "Sister City" relationship between Guam and Pangasinan would be highly beneficial; and

WHEREAS, such a "Sister City" relationship is defined as an officially
approved, long-term partnership between two (2) communities from different
countries, and such official relationships can involve very diverse activities,
including municipal, professional, educational, cultural and business-related
projects; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore the intent of the Committee on Rules of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to request of the Honorable Amado T. Espino, Jr., Governor of the Province of Pangasinan, Republic of the Philippines, and the Honorable Jose Ferdinand Z. Calimlim, Jr., the Vice Governor and Presiding Officer of the Provincial Board of the Province of Pangasinan, Republic of the Philippines, their concurrence in an official long-term, "Sister City" relationship between the Province of Pangasinan, Republic of the Philippines and the island
