WHEREAS, Mr. Jesus Aguon Aquiningoc was born on October 10, 1932; and 4 is the son of Juan and Concepcion Aquiningoc from the beautiful village of Umatac; 5 and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Jesus Aguon Aquiningoc, also known as "Jess" to close family and friends, has ten (10) brothers and sisters: Juan, Rita, Christina, Jose, 7 8 Maria, Carlos, Cecilia, Joaquin, Manuel and Larry; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc graduated from George Washington High
 School, and soon afterwards he started in his public service career by joining the
 Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1953, and during his 4 military service he had received several commendations and awards, to include the 5 6 Good Conduct Medal (Seventh Award); а Letter of Commendation (COMNAVMARIANAS); a Meritorious Unit Commendation (NAVMAG Guam); 7 the National Defense Service Medal; the Korean Service Medal; the United Nations 8 9 Service Medal; the China Service Medal; and the Navy Commendation Medal; and

WHEREAS, in 1957, Mr. Aquiningoc married his first love, Maria Quinata
Sanchez of *Umatac*, the daughter of Joaquin and Milagro Sanchez; and

- WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc and his wife, Maria, have four (4) beautiful
 children: Leslie, Ruby, Mark and Rodney; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc successfully completed twenty-six (26) years of
 Naval Service with his twilight tour at the Office of Chief of Naval Information,
 where he served as the leading Chief Petty Officer of his Directorate, Pentagon,
 Washington, D.C.; and

18 WHEREAS, upon the completion of his Naval journey, and because of the 19 love for his home in the beautiful village of *Umatac*, Mr. Aquiningoc brought his 20 family back to Guam in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc then continued to utilize his administrative skills
as the Administrative Personnel Officer at the University of Guam; and

WHEREAS, after a short tenure with the University of Guam, Mr. Aquiningoc
 moved on to another calling as the Administrative Services Officer with the
 Department of Parks and Recreation; and

1 WHEREAS, while employed with the Department of Parks and Recreation. 2 Mr. Aquiningoc worked closely with then First Lady Madeleine Bordallo on the 3 Beautification Task Force, serving as its President; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc, who was always striving to serve the community 5 and family, was elected by his community to serve as Mayor of the beautiful village 6 of Umatac; and

WHEREAS, while serving as Mayor, Mr. Aquiningoc's wife, Maria, had 7 8 passed on, at which time he decided not to seek re-election, but yet he continued to 9 serve the community in many ways; and

10 WHEREAS, while living in Virginia, Mr. Aquiningoc had served as the President of the Guam Society of Norfolk, Virginia; as well as contributing while on 11 12 Guam in the Parish of San Dionisio, Umatac, where he served as the President of the Parish Council, and he was a member of the Knights of Columbus; and 13

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc was a very humble man, and was well known for 15 his respect, generosity, kindness and caring ways to family, friends, and all who came 16 to know him; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc and his wife, Maria, share strong moral values 18 which were instilled upon their children:.. "to love one another";... "that it's better to be rich in friends than rich in money";.. "to respect others in order to earn the respect 19 of others";.. "to treat others as you would want to be treated";..
