4 government of Guam career with the Department of Public Health and Social Services
5 (DPHSS), where she was employed as a General Helper; and

3 organization quickly, as she was eventually promoted and given various assignments,
4 from a Probation Clerk II and III to that of an Assistant Payment Worker; and

14 receiving her certification from the Department of Public Health and Social Services;

17 with the same energy, focus and drive she has had since when she first started her
18 career with the Department thirty-five (35) years ago; Susan’s caring qualities, her
19 sense of humor, and her generosity is what she has always shared with others, and is

22 DPHSS employees through her hard work and dedication to her position, and the
