Relative to commending and congratulating the Bank of Guam, and the Leon Guerrero family on the occasion of the Fortieth (40th) Year Anniversary of one of Guam's most iconic institutions; and to further extending a most sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to the *Bankon Ifit* family for the Bank of Guam's continued contributions to the growth and progress of Guam and its people.

1	BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN
2	GUÅHAN:
3	WHEREAS, the Bank of Guam, also known as "Bankon Ifit", was officially
4	chartered on March 13, 1972, and on March 13, 2012, will celebrate its Fortieth (40 th)
5	Year Anniversary of providing excellent banking services to the people of the western
6	Pacific region; and
7	WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" was officially chartered by its founder and former
8	Chairman of the Board, the late Jesus S. Leon Guerrero, on March 13, 1972, with One
9	Million Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500,000) in equity. Success for the institution came
10	quickly, with the bank reaching profitability within a mere six (6) weeks; and they
11	built their first three (3) story headquarters in 1975, which is now the site of the Santa
12	Cruz Branch; and
13	WHEREAS, the young, growing banking institution came to the aid of the
14	community after Guam was struck by Super Typhoon Pamela in April 1976, with
15	"Bankon Ifit" distributing food stamps to disaster victims, offering emergency home
16	repair loans, and extending a Five Million Dollar (\$5,000,000) loan to the government
17	of Guam for typhoon relief; and
18	WHEREAS, the original location of the newly established business was in a
19	pre-fabricated building in Hagåtña; and by 1978, "Bankon Ifit" had expanded to a
20	second (2 nd) branch in <i>Tamuning</i> ; and
21	WHEREAS, in the 1980s, "Bankon Ifit" continued its rapid growth, opening
22	seven (7) new branches in Dededo and Tumon Bay, Guam; San Francisco, California;
23	Garapan, Saipan; the islands of Rota and Tinian; and in Ebeye, Kwajalein; and
24	WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" also acquired the Bank of America's branches in
25	the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI), Eastern Caroline and

- 1 the Marshall Islands; and the American Savings and Loan Association branches in
- 2 Belau and Pohnpei; and
- WHEREAS, by the end of the 1980s, "Bankon Ifit" had introduced the first
- 4 automated teller machines (ATMs) on Guam, providing twenty-four (24) hour
- 5 banking to their customers; and Bank of Guam's assets exceeded Three Hundred
- 6 Million Dollars (\$300,000,000), with profits topping Six Million Dollars
- 7 (\$6,000,000); and
- 8 WHEREAS, in the 1990s, "Bankon Ifit" opened a historic island landmark,
- 9 their ten (10)-story headquarters building in Hagåtña, one of the island's most
- 10 recognizable landmarks; they launched Telephone Voice Banking; and contributed
- 11 One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to the American Red Cross for Guam's
- typhoon relief in the aftermath of Super Typhoon Paka; and
- WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" transitioned smoothly into the new millennium, the
- 14 first decade of which brought the twin challenges of the loss of founder Mr. Jesus S.
- 15 Leon Guerrero, who passed away on August 27, 2002, and Mr. Anthony A. Leon
- 16 Guerrero, eldest son of Mr. Leon Guerrero, who served as Vice Chairman of the
- 17 Board, President and Chief Executive Officer from 1985 until 2002, when he became
- 18 Chairman of the Board, and held all three (3) positions until his untimely passing on
- 19 October 9, 2005; and
- WHEREAS, despite the loss of the "Bankon Ifit" leadership, the Leon
- 21 Guerrero and Bank of Guam families persevered in the first decade of the new
- 22 millennium, with the elevation of Ms. Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, a former Senator in
- 23 the 24th, 26th, 27th, and 28th Guam Legislatures, to the positions of Board Chair,
- 24 President, and Chief Executive Officer on April 3, 2006; and
- 25 WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" continued its expansion, opening Primevest
- 26 Financial and BGInsurance; establishing two (2) more bank branches in Yap and

- 1 Kosrae; opened its new *Mangilao* branch on January 30, 2012, continuing twenty-one
- 2 (21) years of presence in the village; completed construction of a branch in Pohnpei;
- 3 launched internet banking; established the groundwork for a Virtual Private Network
- 4 (VPN); began Voice Over Internet Technology (VOIP) conversion; and expanded its
- 5 network of ATMs to more than eighty (80) machines, reaching from San Francisco,
- 6 California, to the Federated States of Micronesia; and formed the Bank Guam Holding
- 7 Company, all while submitting winning Small Business Association (SBA)
- 8 nominations; and
- 9 **WHEREAS,** in contributing to the community, "Bankon Ifit" hosted the "5K
- 10 Ifit Run for Guam Cancer Care" on March 10, 2012, to assist local nonprofit
- organizations in helping Guam's cancer patients; and has entered an award-winning
- team for this year's Relay for Life; and
- WHEREAS, education is a priority of "Bankon Ifit", with twenty (20) of its
- officers having been sent to Pacific Coast Banking School, seventy-three (73) staffers
- 15 having received college degrees, while thirteen (13) have postgraduate degrees; and
- 16 "Bankon Ifit" will be awarding and matching a Five Thousand Dollar (\$5,000) Accel
- 17 Education Grant to issue Two Thousand Dollar (\$2,000) awards for five (5)
- 18 graduating high school seniors, in addition to offering generous tuition assistance to
- 19 its employees, eight (8) of whom are currently enrolled in school this year; and
- 20 WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" has matured into a billion-dollar financial
- 21 institution, with a reach that spans the broad Pacific with roots firmly planted in our
- 22 island home; and now, at the mark of its Fortieth (40th) Year Anniversary, "Bankon
- 23 Ifit" celebrates its local staff, with its Senior Management having over two hundred
- 24 (200) years of financial services experience; now therefore, be it
- 25 **RESOLVED,** that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
- on behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate the Bank of Guam, and

- 1 the entire Leon Guerrero and Bank of Guam Families on the occasion of the Fortieth
- 2 (40th) Year Anniversary of "Bankon Ifit", one of Guam's most iconic financial
- 3 institutions; and to further extending a most sincere Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse
- 4 to "Bankon Ifit" for their continued contributions to the growth and progress of
- 5 Guam's economy, culture and people; and be it further
- 6 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
- 7 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mrs.
- 8 Lourdes A. (Lou) Leon Guerrero, Board Chair, President and CEO, Bank of Guam; to
- 9 Mrs. Eugenia Leon Guerrero, widow of the late Jesus A. Leon Guerrero; and to the
- 10 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
