- WHEREAS, the Laguna Association of Guam is a Filipino organization whose
- 4 ideals are to promote brotherhood and camaraderie; to protect the interest of its
- 5 members; and to invite all Filipinos and Fil-Chamorros, regardless of province-birth,

who are eager and willing to be adopted sons and daughters of the historical province of Laguna, Philippines; and

WHEREAS, the Laguna Association of Guam was first conceptualized by the various families on Guam from different towns of Laguna, Philippines, who had a vision of hope for camaraderie and service to the community; and

WHEREAS, the vision of these individuals came to reality at their first organizational meeting held on January 17, 2000, with forty-eight (48) individuals representing twenty-eight (28) families from Laguna, Philippines, in attendance; and

WHEREAS, the first membership meeting was then held on January 30, 2000, with thirty (30) towns from Laguna being represented by one hundred fifty (150) individuals; and the first meeting of the Executive Board was held on February 23, 2000, which led the way to a formal certification of the Association on September 17, 2001 by the Guam Department of Revenue and Taxation; and

WHEREAS, since the establishment of the Association, the members of the Laguna Association have participated in numerous fundraisers and special events for the benefit of many charitable organizations, including: the Guam Lytico and Bodig Association; the American Red Cross; the American Cancer Society; the Alee Shelter; the Guam Skilled Nursing Facility; the Catholic Social Service; the Make-A-Wish Foundation; the Mindanao Catholic Church Renovation Project; the Philippine National Red Cross; and various foundations for abused children and disaster victims in Guam and the Philippines; and

**WHEREAS**, other worthwhile donations from the Association include the trash containers for *Guma Trankilidad*, for Two Lovers Point, and for Liberation Day Festivities; and

WHEREAS, the Laguna Association of Guam had also donated playground equipment for the students of D.L. Perez Elementary School, the *Ordot-Chalan Pago* 

1 Elementary School, and *Upi* Elementary School through a matching federal grant; and

donated textbooks for the students of Maria Ulloa Elementary School, as well as

3 schools in the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, in December 2001, the Association donated a public picnic shelter, with barbeque pit and shower facilities, at the *Paseo de Susana* Park in *Hagåtña*, with subsequent upgrades to the shelter that included additional concrete walkways and picnic tables and benches; and

WHEREAS, a bust statue of Dr. Jose Rizal, a Philippine National Hero who was born in Calamba, Laguna, was purchased by the Laguna Association of Guam and installed at the official residence of the Philippine Consul General in *Tamuning* to be used as a site for Filipinos of Guam to gather and honor the National Hero on his birthday and Rizal Day; and

WHEREAS, the driving force behind the achievements of the Laguna Association of Guam has been the commitment of its leaders and members, as well as support from the business community of Guam, and the help of families and friends; and
