Relative to bringing further awareness to shark conservation; to supporting the enactment of protective legislation; to commending regional leaders for their commitment and the implementation of the Micronesia Regional Shark Sanctuary encompassing the waters of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Republic of Palau, Northern Mariana Islands, and Guam; and to commend and congratulate the students and staff of George Washington High School and Simon Sanchez High School for their Shark Advocacy.

1	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES I
2	MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:
3	WHEREAS, according to fossil records, sharks have played an important role
4	in the balance of our oceans' ecosystem for about four hundred fifty (450) million
5	years; and
6	WHEREAS, sharks grow very slowly and take a long time to reach sexual
7	maturity - twenty (20) years or more in some species. When they do reproduce, they
8	produce very few offspring compared to other bony fish species; and
9	WHEREAS, each year, millions of sharks die after being caught on longlines
10	ranging in length from one mile to over one hundred (100) miles with fish bait
11	intended to catch tuna and swordfish; and
12	WHEREAS, due to their slow rate of growth, shark populations cannot sustain
13	current slaughter rates; and
14	WHEREAS, declining shark populations will have serious consequences for
15	ocean ecosystems because they are vital to the food chain and their predatory nature
16	helps to keep populations of their fish prey in check; and
17	WHEREAS, without sharks preserving a healthy balance, coral reefs and the
18	entire marine environment risk immense permanent damage; and
19	WHEREAS, through Public Law 31-10 and the recent unanimous passage of
20	Bill No. 405-31 (COR), I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan has taken
21	significant steps to thwart the pernicious practice of shark overfishing; and
22	WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan supports Hawaii's
23	passage of SB 2169 to prohibit the sale, possession or distribution of shark fins and fin
24	products; and further supports the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands'
25	passage of H.B. 17-94; and

1	WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan supports President
2	Barack Obama signing the Shark Conservation Act into law and further supports the
3	Republic of Palau for creating the world's first shark sanctuary; and
4	WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan commends and
5	congratulates former President Jurelang Zedkaia for passing strong legislation to
6	create the Marshall Islands National Shark Sanctuary (MINSS) and further commends
7	President Christopher Loeak for implementing enforcement; and
8	WHEREAS, the MINSS is 768,547 square miles, an area four times the
9	landmass of California, and the strong legislation prohibits the commercial fishing of
10	sharks, the sale of sharks, a ban on certain longline fishing gear used to target sharks,
11	and stringent fines between \$25,000 and \$200,000 for anyone found to be fishing for
12	sharks or in possession of sharks; and
13	WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan supports the Palau
14	Shark Sanctuary created in 2009 by President Johnson Toribiong that protects sharks
15	in an area roughly the size of France from illegal poachers and commercial fishing of
16	sharks; and
17	WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes and
18	congratulates the presidents and governors attending the 15th Micronesian Chief
19	Executive Summit for agreeing to a Micronesia Regional Shark Sanctuary
20	encompassing the waters of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of
21	Micronesia, Republic of Palau, Northern Mariana Islands, and Guam; and
22	WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan supports the
23	implementation of the Micronesia Regional Shark Sanctuary; and
24	WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes and
25	congratulates the Simon Sanchez Sharks for their unyielding advocacy in support of
26	shark conservation; and

1 WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes and congratulates the George Washington Geckos for their unyielding advocacy in support 2 3 of shark conservation; and now therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 4 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 5 6 of Guam, recognize and honor former President Jurelang Zedkaia for the successful 7 creation of the Marshall Islands National Shark Sanctuary; and be it further 8 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 9 of Guam, recognize and honor President Christopher Loeak for the successful 10 11 implementation of the Marshall Islands National Shark Sanctuary; and be it further RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 12 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 13 14 of Guam, recognize and honor President Johnson Toribiong for declaring and implementing the Palau Shark Sanctuary; and be it further 15 16 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 17 18 of Guam, recognize and honor Governor Benigno Fitial for signing the Northern 19 Mariana Islands Shark Fin Ban into law; and be it further RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 20 21 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 22 of Guam, recognize and honor Governor Eddie Calvo for signing the Guam Shark Fin 23 Ban into law; and be it further RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Unu Na 24 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 25

of Guam, extend a most sincere Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse' to the Simon
