Relative to recognizing and commending the front line staff of all the government of Guam agencies, and private nonprofit organizations, who work tirelessly to assist and treat the victims of child abuse and neglect, and also work towards its prevention to make Guam safer; and to further extending *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to them for their continued commitment to reducing the incidences of child abuse on Guam, and for bringing attention to, and promoting the knowledge and awareness of, the issue of child abuse and neglect, and especially of child sexual assault on Guam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect, including child sexual assault, are social problems that contribute to significant personal challenges for the victims, and to the decay of our families and communities as strong, viable units; and

6 WHEREAS, there were one thousand eight hundred ninety-seven (1,897) 7 reports of child abuse and neglect cases on Guam affecting two thousand five hundred 8 twelve (2,512) children, an increase from 2011 of nearly forty percent (40%); and

9 WHEREAS, as well, there were over three thousand (3,000) other reports of 10 referrals to the Department of Public Health and Social Services' Child Protective 11 Services, signaling an urgent call for help in the protection of Guam's children, youth 12 and families; and

WHEREAS, the incidences of child abuse and neglect often result in lifelong challenges to the victims, thwarting their personal development and abilities to be productive citizens; and

WHEREAS, the victims of child abuse and neglect are more likely to be at risk for having depression and other mental illnesses; for substance abuse; to struggle to sustain educational and work activities; and to maintain healthy interpersonal relationships; and

WHEREAS, the hundreds of victims each year who are cases of substantiated abuse and neglect also impact thousands more individuals who they live and work with, and who are their family, friends and neighbors; and

WHEREAS, the community response to the tragedy of child abuse and neglect rests with our families, communities, and all of our agencies, both private and governmental; and

WHEREAS, there is a core group of individuals in these agencies who are on the front lines ready and willing to assist twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week, including holidays, to protect and support victims of child abuse and neglect; and

5 WHEREAS, these individuals and agencies should be acknowledged for their 6 selfless dedication and commitment to our children, youth and families; now 7 therefore, be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, 9 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the Department of Mental 10 Health and Substance Abuse; the Department of Public Health and Social Services; 11 the Department of Youth Affairs; the Guam Police Department; the Office of the Attorney General; the Superior Court of Guam; Sanctuary, Incorporated; Catholic 12 Social Service; Victims Advocates Reaching Out (VARO); and the Guam Coalition 13 14 Against Sexual Assault and Family Violence's (GCASAFV); and does further support 15 them in their efforts to increase the awareness and the strategies to prevent child abuse 16 and neglect on Guam, as they continuously work in collaboration with public and 17 private entities to significantly reduce the incidences of this destructive social ill; and be it further 18

Calvo, I Maga'lahen Guåhan.
